Questions: as a driver


Q1: Do you drive car? / Q2: How often do you drive?

Questions: as a driver — sound of your won car


- Q4: How do you think about the sound quality of your car?
 - → Comfortable (50%), Feel nothing special (21%)
- Q5: How do you think about the sound level of your driving sound?



- Q6: If the driving sound becomes too quiet to be audible, how would you think?
 - → Good, because it is quiet (46%)
 - → Dangerous, because it is difficult to feel the speed (29%)

 Q7: Have you ever felt dangerous and/or unsatisfaction due to the pedestrians' unawareness of your driving car?




Q7-1: Which time of the day?

Questions: as a driver — Quiet problem

- Q7-1: If you have understand why pedestrian(s) did not aware your car, please describe it.
 - They were in a hurry and not aware of the traffic.
 - They crossed the street without checking traffic sufficiently.
 - The pedestrian underestimate the speed.
 - Because my car's existence(noise) was buried within many cars and other environmental sounds.
 - Mostly they are old, they are not able to hear correctly.

Questions: as a pedestrian — Quiet problem


 Q8: Have you ever felt dangerous and/or surprise due to the unaware car approaching?

 How much traffic?



 Q8-1: Chose the most applying item as a reason why you did not aware.




Questions: as a pedestrian — Quiet problem

Q8-2: What kind of car was that?




Questions: as a pedestrian — HV/EV experience
