

### What is the global problem?


- At least 1.3 million people are killed each year
- 260,000 children die each year
- At least 15 million people seriously injured
- 90% of injuries in middle and low income countries






#### Make Roads Safe: the case for action

- Should be addressed like comparable global issues such as Malaria, TB & HIV AIDS
- Impacts on social and economic development - \$100 billion annual cost to developing countries
- Immediate cost effective 'vaccines' are available: helmets, seat belts, road design improvements
- First Make Roads Safe report recommended Global Ministerial Conference on Road Safety


#### **Changing Direction: Projected Global Road Fatalities**







- Post crash care












### Resourcing a Decade of Action


