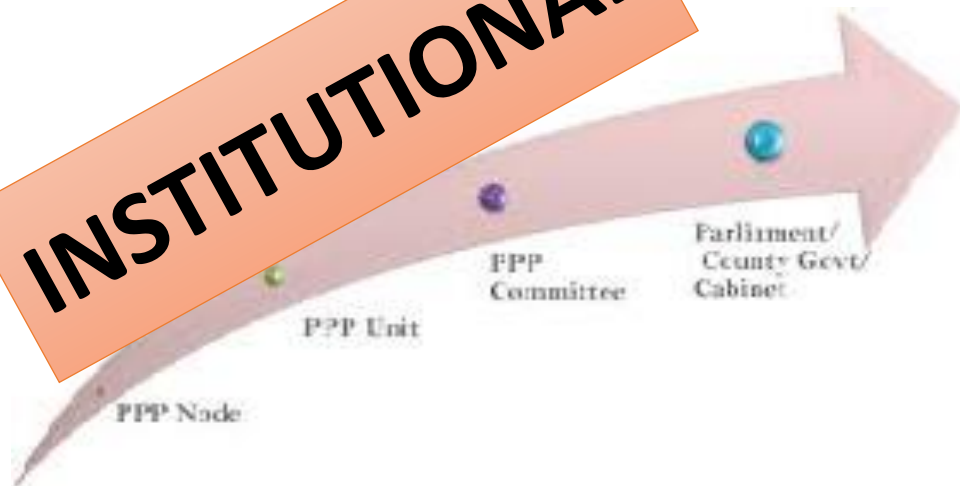

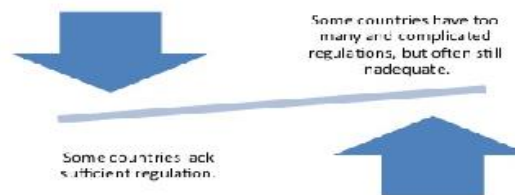

Regulatory Framework

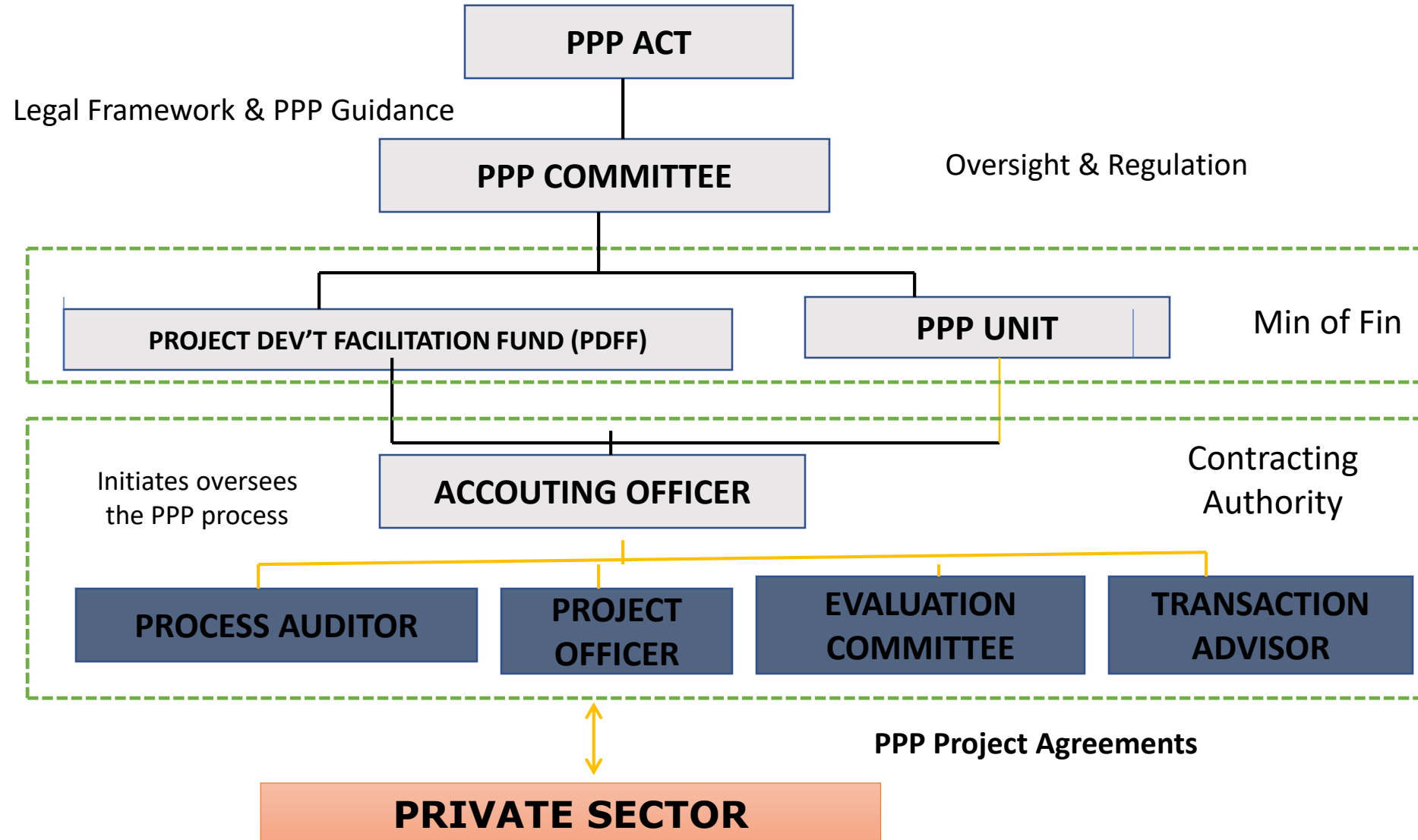


 The main regulation should be at the proper level in regulatory hierarchy of respective country, since PPP involves cross sectors and institutions.

 PPP regulations can be dynamic but should be kept straightforward and (quite) simple.

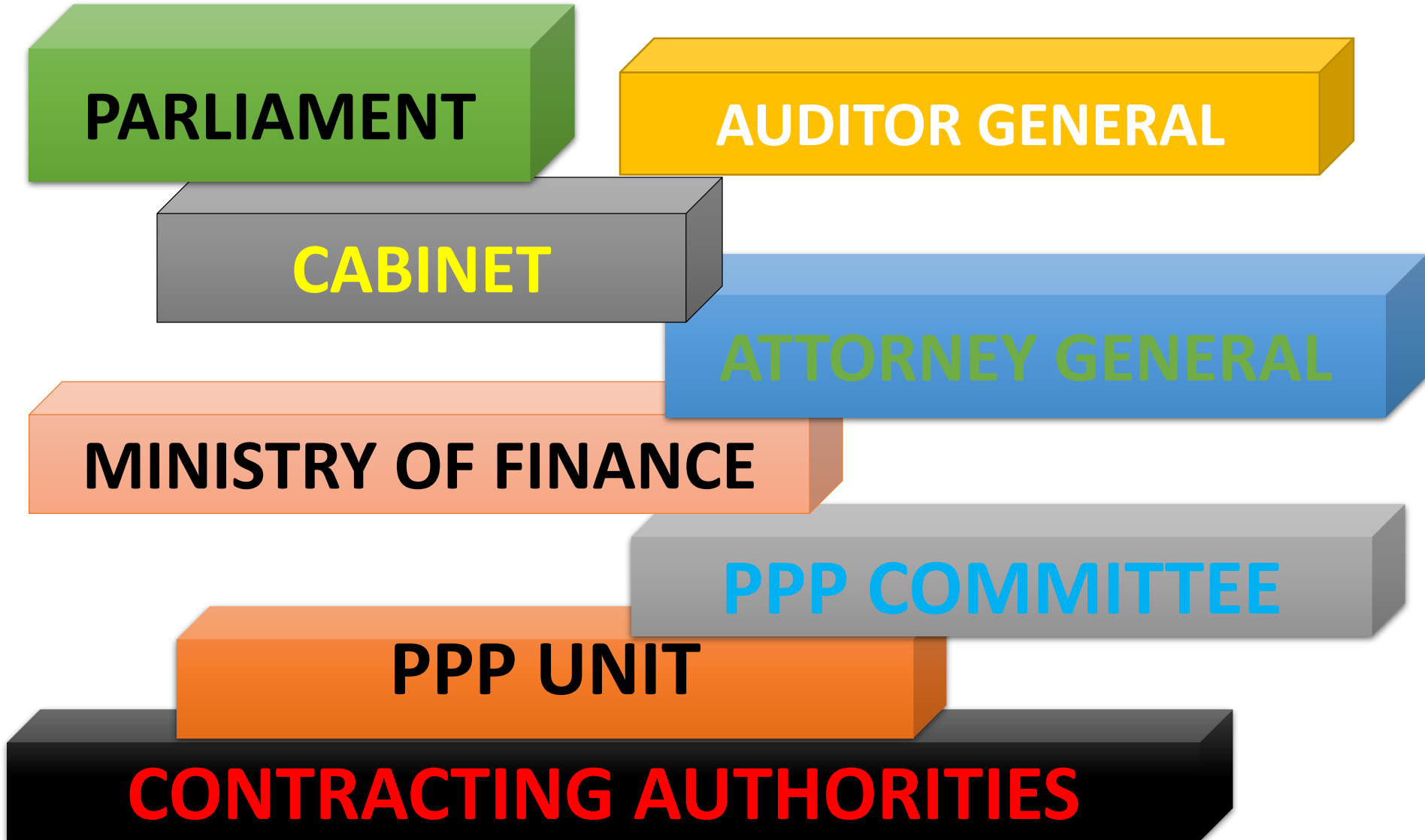


PPP GOVERNANCE F/W



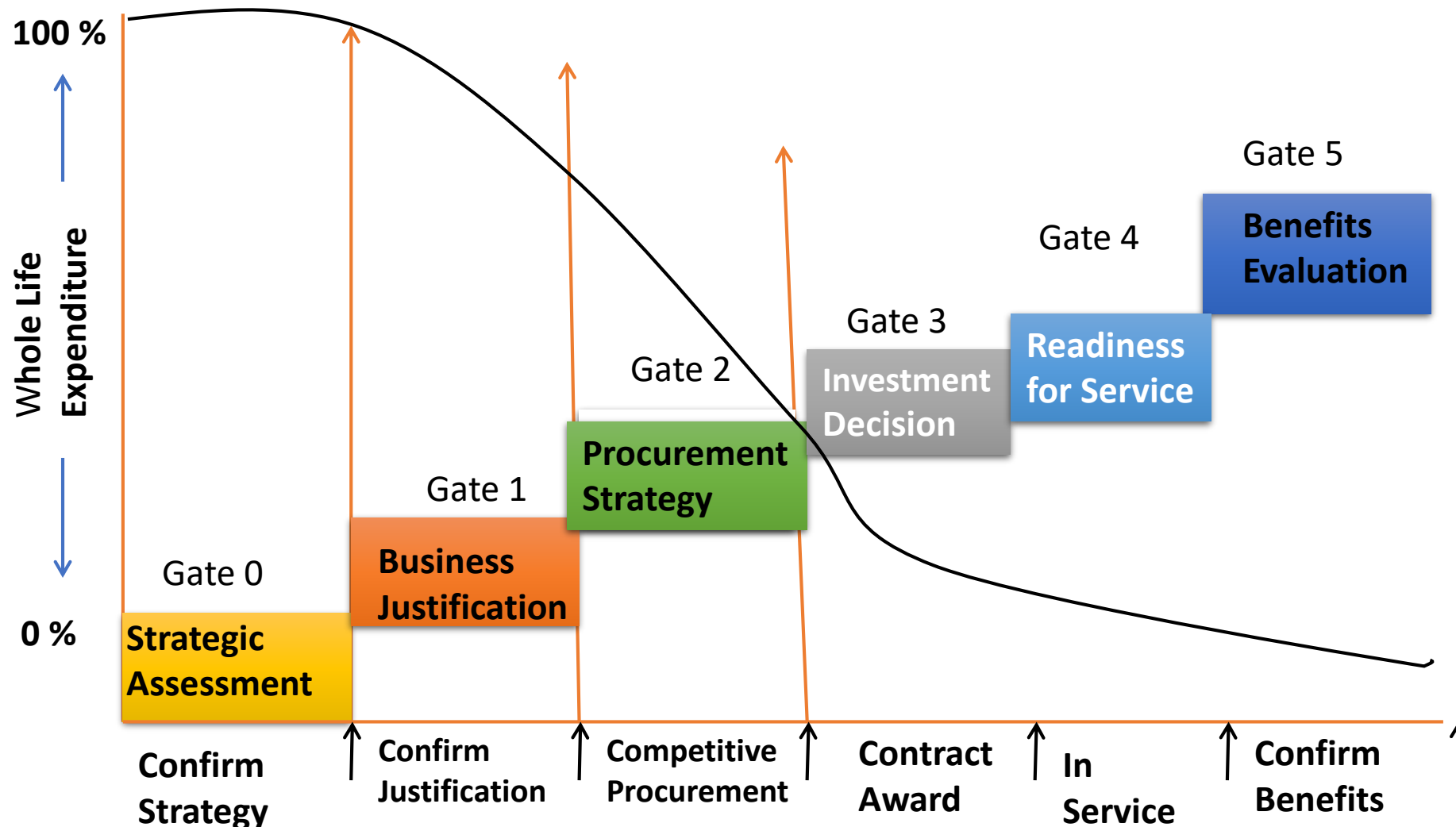


KEY INSTITUTIONS IN ADMN OF PPPS

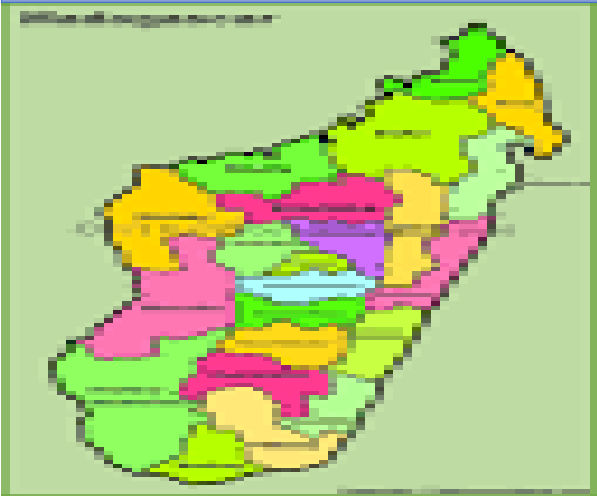

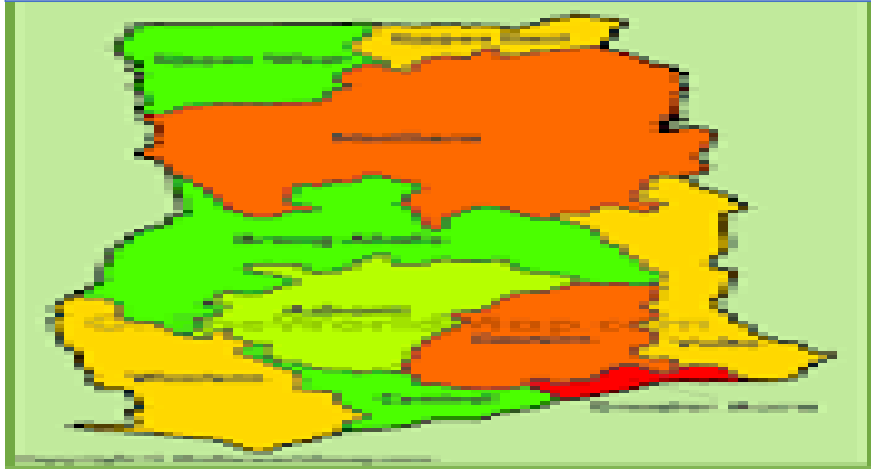

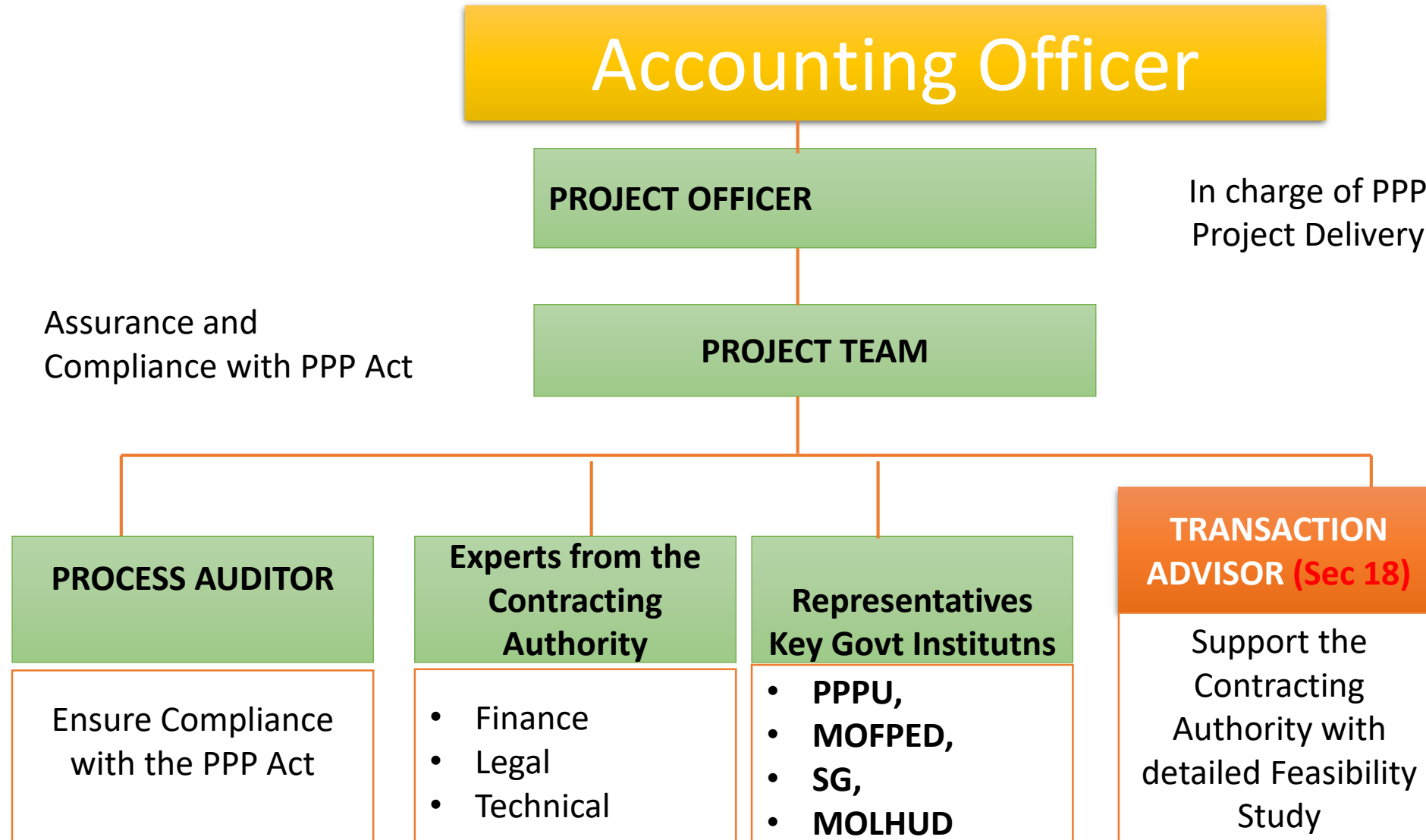
