Poland and Ukraine to host EURO 2012

- Significant increase in planned investments into sports & recreation infrastructure;
- **4 billion euros** – value of all planned sports & recreation projects in Poland.



Financing of Euro 2012 projects

- Euro 2012 is a project comprising design, construction, redevelopment or renovation of stadiums and other facilities in Poland, as well as other undertakings necessary to hold the Euro 2012 championships.
- **Funding:**
 - State budget;
 - local self-governments' funds;
 - European Union structural funds;
 - **public-private partnership.**

Current status of PPP projects in Poland

- First projects are implemented, based on cooperation with private partners under partnership formula and concession for building works;
- Problems associated, among others, with partner selection procedure and recognition of obligations within public entity budgets.

Chances of PPP Development

- **A bill to amend the PPP Act** (Ministry of Economy as a leader);
- **PPP Task Force** – private-public initiative;
- **Good PPP Practices Competition** directed to all public entities in Poland, especially to local government organisations (organised by Investment Support).

PPP in Poland – barriers and private investors' point of view

- Public tenders – long procedures and formal obstacles;
- Legal risk;
- Lack of good PPP practices.
