Harmonization of Petroleum and Minerals Classifications

- Summary of Task Force proposals
 - Remove category and sub-category labels, and agree harmonized (generic) definitions of categories and sub-categories
 - Adopt mapping modules for CRIRSCO-UNFC and SPE-UNFC
 - Recommendation that the UNFC document is revised and simplified to reflect proposed changes and mapping modules

Harmonization of Petroleum and Minerals Classifications

- Modifying any classification system
 - Is only justified when it leads to a better system for all users
 - Should accommodate the needs of existing users to the extent possible
 - But ... will usually lead to changes in the reported numbers and/or terminology compared with the existing system (e.g. RF system, PRMS)
