Collecting your UN Entrance Badge

UN entrance badges are obtained at the Pass and Identification Unit of the UNOG Security and Safety Section, located at the Pregny Gate, 14, Avenue de la Paix, opposite the Red Cross Building. Please do not forget to **bring your registration form** with you which you will have to present to the Security Officer together with **your national passport** in order to obtain your entrance badge.

Please allow approximately 45 minutes to obtain your UN Entrance Badge and reach the meeting room.

Directions to Salle XXIV

Once you have entered through the Pregny Gate i.e. past the Security Official, follow the path down to the left in the direction of the E Building (modern building). You will then see a car park and **DOOR 40** directly in front of you. Enter through **DOOR 40**, you are on the 2nd floor. Turn right and take the escalator down to the 1st floor. Salle XXIV is just on your left after Salle XXIII.

Coffee Lounge/Bar Serpent: The entrance of Bar Serpent is just in front of you when exiting Salle XXIV.

Directions to Salle IX

Enter through **DOOR A11**, turn left and take the lift to the 3rd floor, on exiting the lift walk straight ahead and then turn left into a large corridor where you will walk past Salle **VIII** and just after is Salle **IX**.

Directions to Salle VII

Once you have entered through the Pregny Gate i.e. past the Security Official, follow the path down to the right in the direction of the old building. You will then see a small car park and **DOOR A11** directly in front of you (the road will continue down the hill to your right). Enter through **DOOR A11**, turn left and take the lift to the 3rd floor, on exiting the lift walk straight ahead along a large corridor where you will find **SALLE VII** on your right.

To go to the Graduate Institute from the Palais, please refer to the map on page 4. The shortest route is from the **Nations Gate exit** (where the national flags are located), marked by 2 flags on the map. The dotted blue line indicates the route with the Palais to the Nations Gate exit. On exiting from the **Nations Gate**, walk directly across the square to Route de Ferney. Turn left and walk down Route de Ferney (towards Avenue de France and the lake), as indicated by the red dotted line on the map and proceed to: The Graduate Institute (IHEID), Maison de la Paix, Chemin Eugène-Rigot 2.

It is also possible to go by Tram number 15 from Nations (two stops, exit at Stop "France").

Timing of UN Meetings: UN meetings with interpretation run from 10 am to 1pm and from 3 pm – 6pm.
