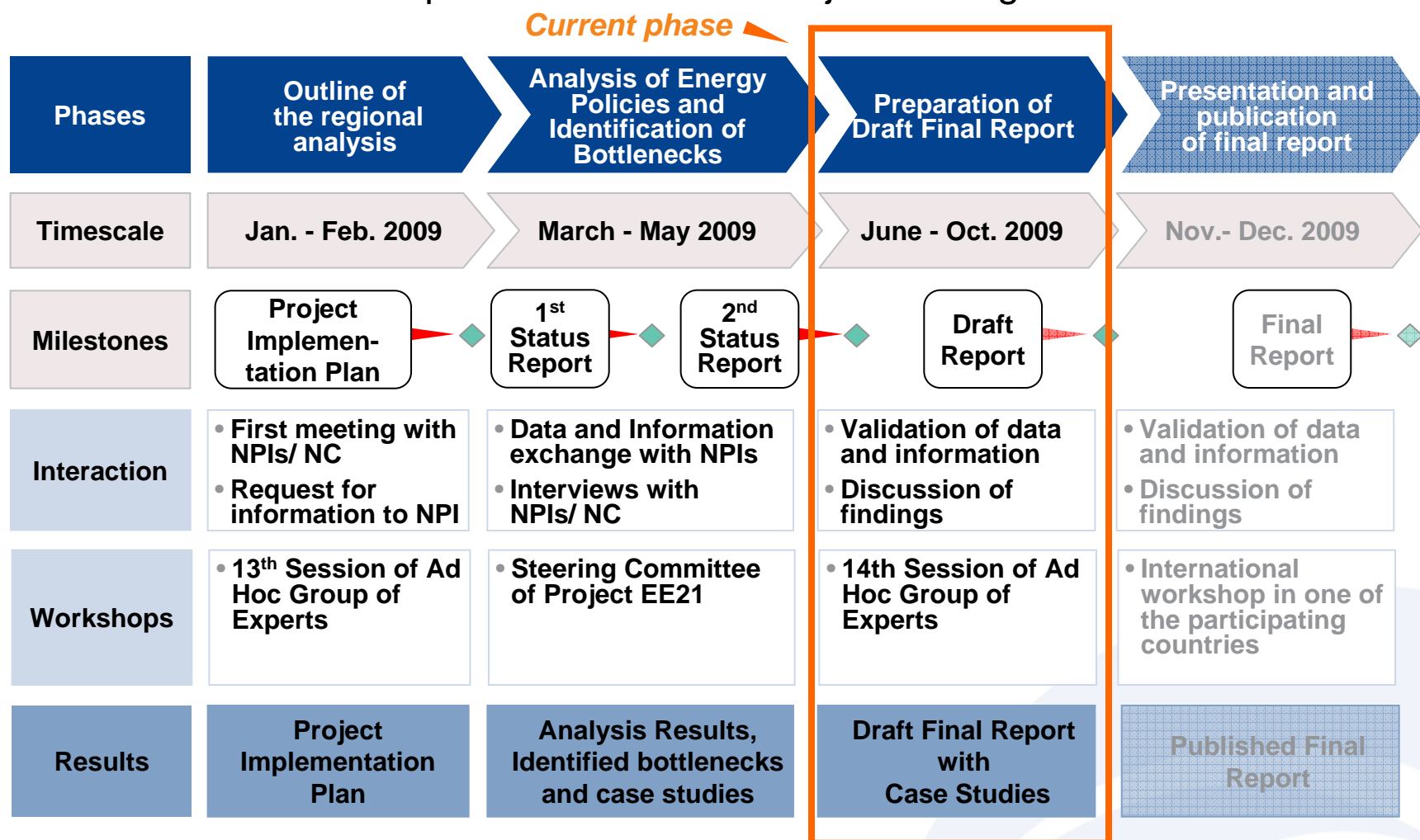
Situation and context

This presentation gives an overview of the current progress of the Regional Analysis of Policy Reforms to promote Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Investments

- In April 2009, the first visits to the project countries (Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia and Croatia) were started and the First Status Report was finalized
- In May 2009, the visits to the project countries and the exchange of information with the National Participating Institutions were successfully set forth
- In June 2009, the focus of the activities was on the consolidation of the results of the analysis phase and in the preparation of the second status report, which has been presented and discussed at the third face-to-face meeting with UNECE PMU on June 29
- In July 2009, Pöyry conducted the last visits to the project countries
- In August 2009, the focus of the activities was in the consolidation of the information received by the National Participating Institutions and finalization of the country analyses
- In September 2009, the focus of the activities was in the preparation of the Draft Final Report including the analysis of the 12 Case Studies and the development of recommendations for policy reform

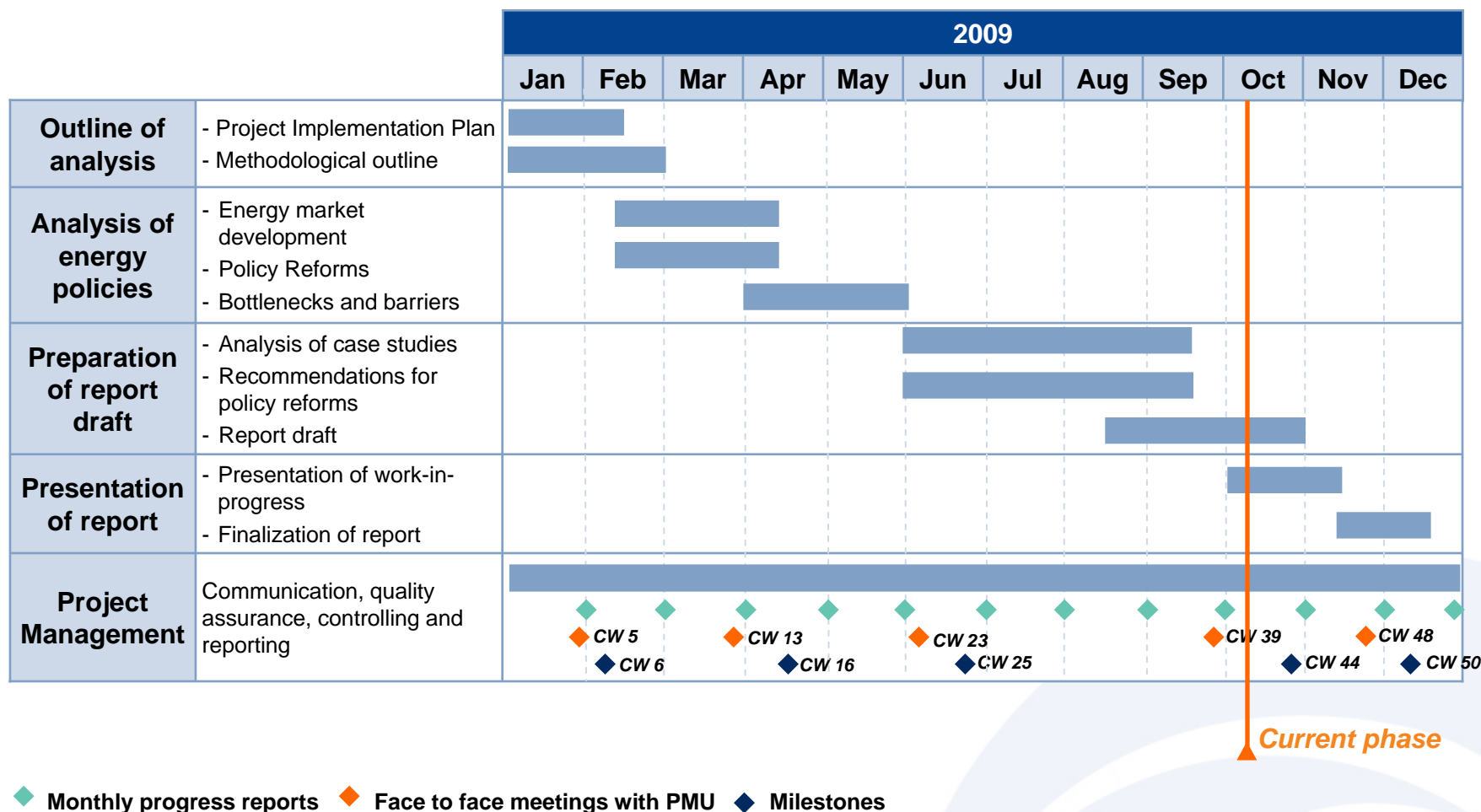
Current project progress

The third phase of the project will be completed shortly with the presentation of the Draft of the Final Report to the UNECE Project Management Unit



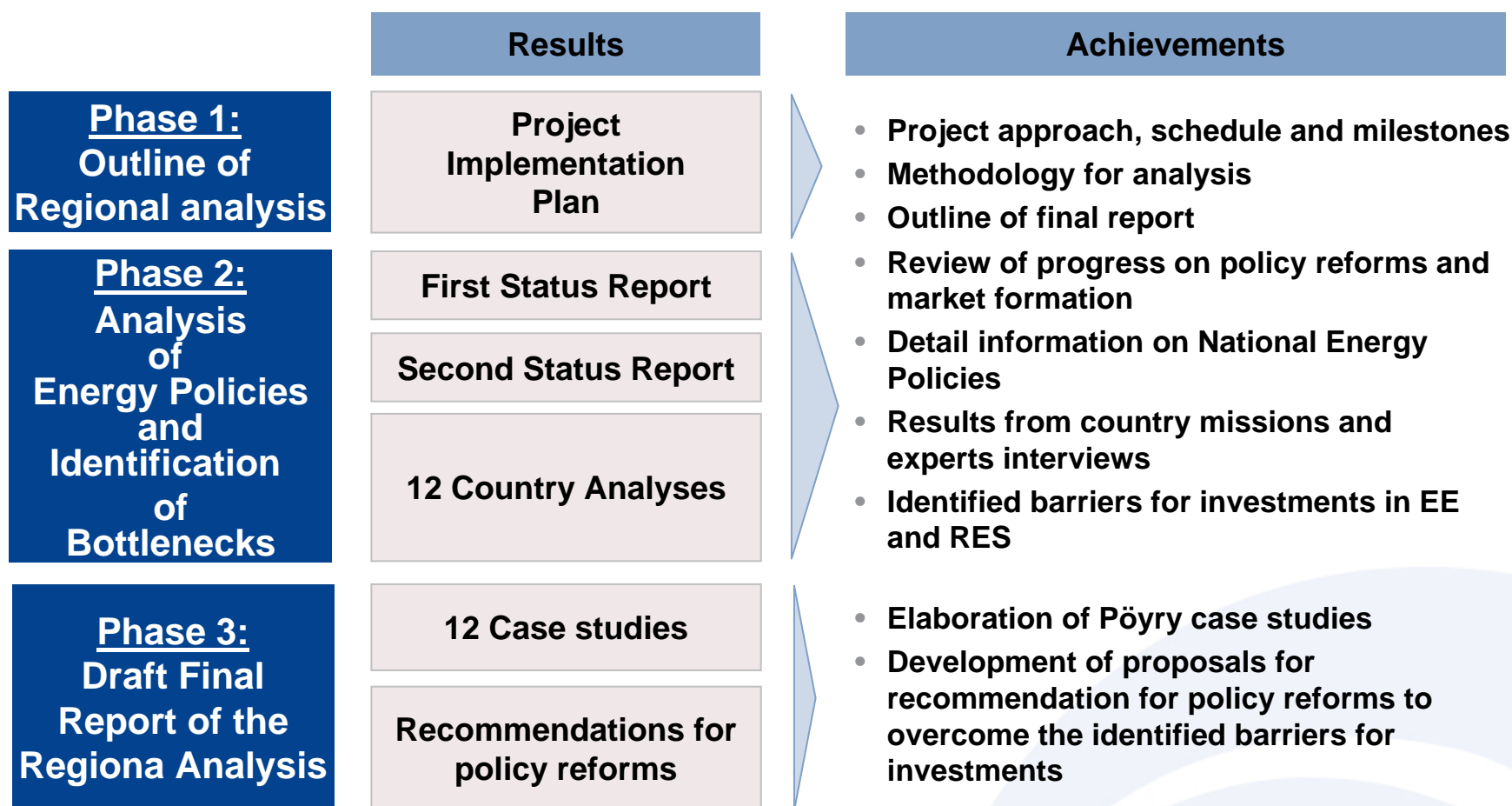
The timeline of the project activities

The project activities are proceeding on-schedule and will be concluded at the end of 2009



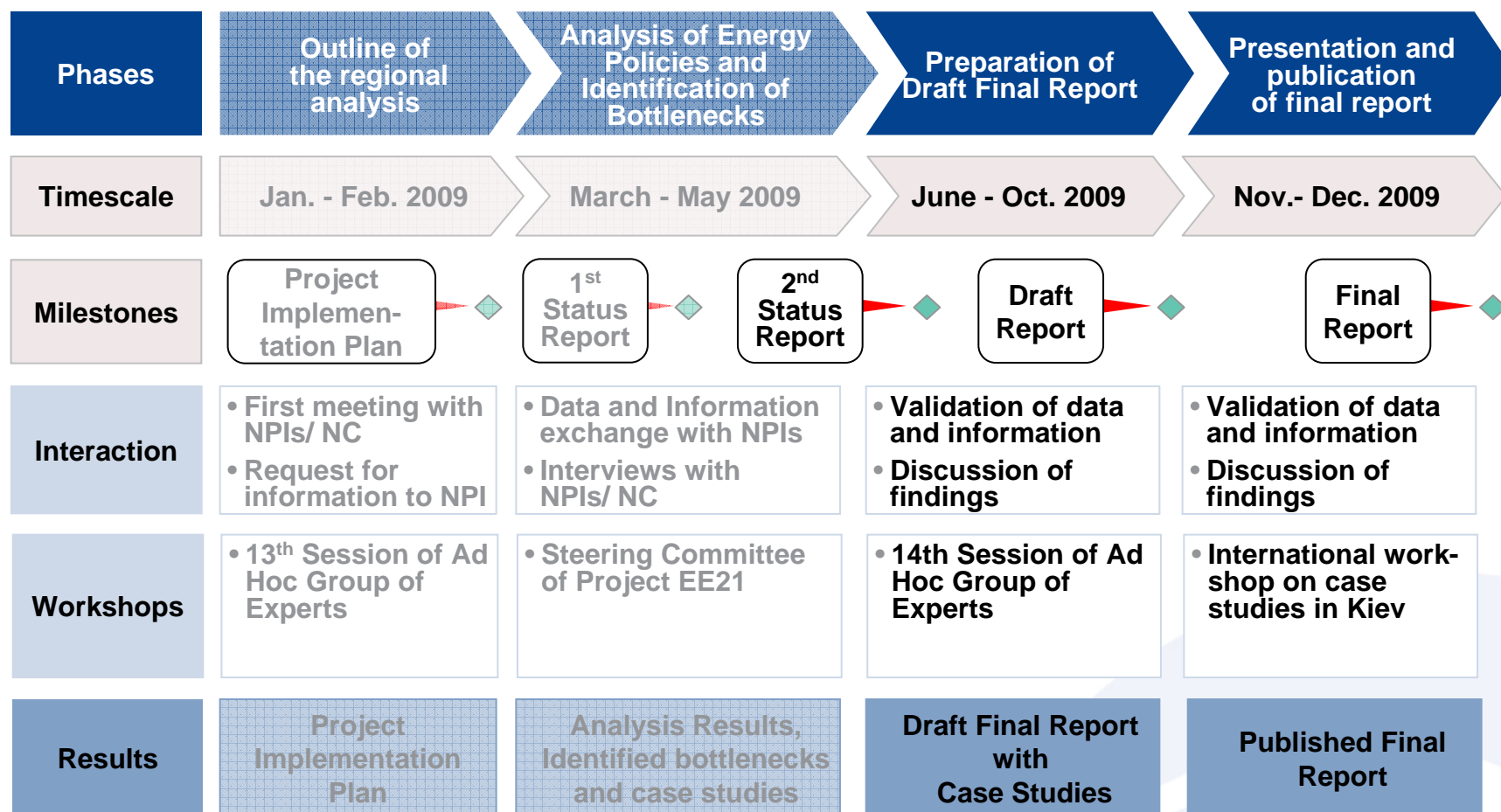
Achievements of the project
