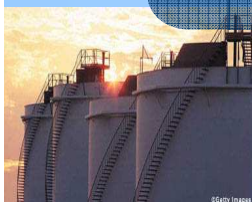

## Background

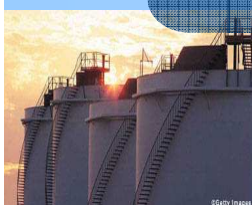
- The Ad Hoc Group of Experts on Energy Efficiency Investments for Climate Change Mitigation at its 14<sup>th</sup> session approved the Work Plan for the Third Year of Project Operations (2010), which foresees the awarding of grants to the NPIs.
- The new grants will serve as continuation of activities assigned to the NPIs in the framework of previous MOUs.



## Description of Assignment under MOU (1)

### National Project Website

- Working in close cooperation with the Website and Internet Communications contractor-EnEffect, to **make fully functional and maintain national project website** (as part of the overall project website or separately) and/or dedicated pages on its own existing website.
- Detailed specifications for the national project website and/or dedicated pages provided by the Website and Internet Communications contractor.

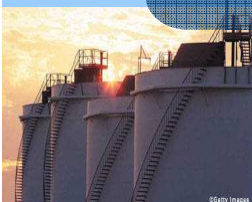


## Description of Assignment under MOU (2)

### Indicative Project Pipeline Proposals

Working in close cooperation with the Investment Fund Designer contractor – Conning Asset Management Limited, to **prepare at least five project proposals** for:

- a) equity and/or mezzanine finance participation of the proposed investment fund in local companies, ESCO, etc;
- b) structure a third party financing using performance contracting;
- c) equity and/or mezzanine participation in energy efficiency or renewable energy projects.

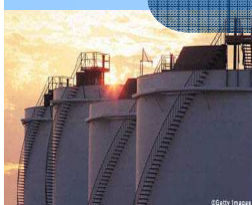


## Description of Assignment under MOU (3)

### Organization of Training/Business Development Courses

Make all necessary arrangements for organization of training/business development courses in the country, in particular:

- a) identify and invite participants of the training courses based on analysis of submitted project identification forms;
- b) distribute information materials provided by Conning Asset Management Limited and trainers to selected participants ;
- c) provide facilities to hold training courses.



## Conditions for awarding of grants to NPIs

- The duration of grant is **one year** from the date of signature of the MOU.
- Proposed amount of grant is **US\$ 35,000**, out of which:
  - \$5,000 for national project website;
  - \$10,000 for organization of training/business development courses;
  - \$20,000 for preparation of indicative project pipeline proposals.
- Period of grant awarding for NPIs in selected countries: July-August 2010.
- Award of remaining grants is subject to further availability of funds.
