Project goal and objectives

Goal:

Increased inflow of internal investments in energy efficiency projects in the state sector.

Objective 1:

Increase of incentives for the budgetary (state financed) organizations to invest in energy conservation measures.

Objective 2:

More efficient use of financial resources for energy efficiency projects in the state sector.

Objective 3:

Replication of project results in Belarus.

Projects implemented

Construction of mini-CHP plants using gas reciprocating installations at:

- ✓ **“Berezastroimaterialy” public corporation – 1 MW,**
- ✓ **«Krasnoselskstroimaterialy» public corporation - 4.8 MW,**
- ✓ **“Keramika” public corporation – 2.8 MW,**

Total amount of investments is more than 12 mln.US\$, including 6 mln. US\$ of debt capital.

Undergoing projects

- ✓ **Introduction of two gas reciprocating installations of total electric power capacity 3.6 MW and heat power capacity of 3.8 MW at “Sluzki myasokombinat” public corporation.**
- ✓ **Introduction of a gas reciprocating installation of electric power capacity 1.4 MW and heat power capacity of 1.2 MW at “Ivatsevichskiy” housing and communal services.**

Training

- **International consultant on training (company “НИЦЭ-НН”, Russia) has been selected.**
- **The consultant has conducted one out of three training sessions “The methodology of energy audit and business planning of energy efficiency projects” for Belarusian specialists.**
