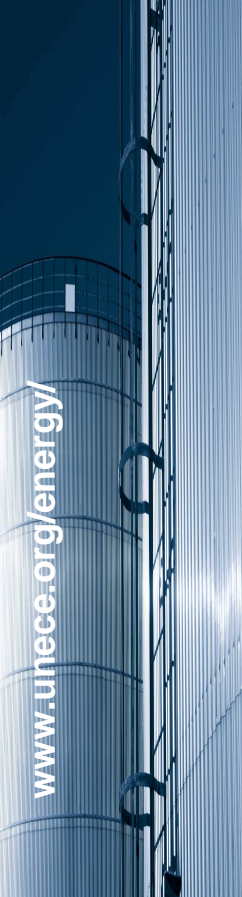


Energy Efficiency 21 (EE21)

(from Inter-agency framework mechanism to a platform)

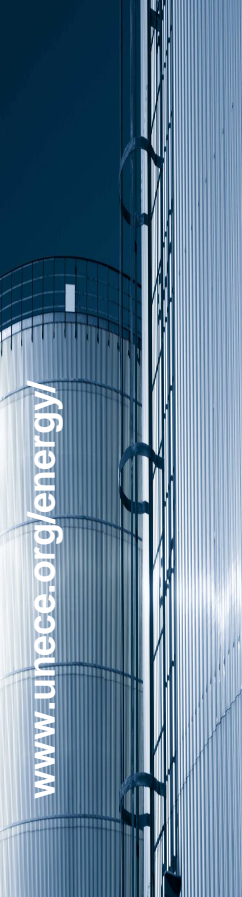

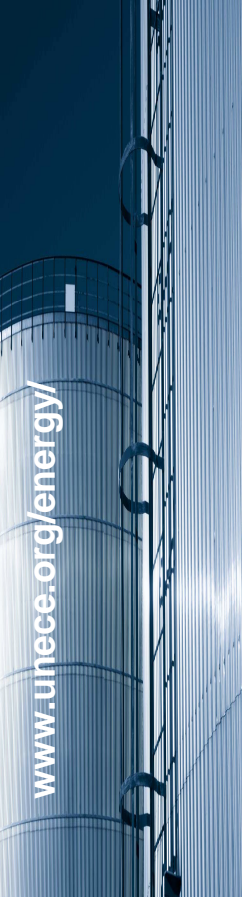
DA Project Proposal

« Promoting Global and Regional Market Formation for Energy Efficiency Investments for Climate Change Mitigation and Sustainable Development »



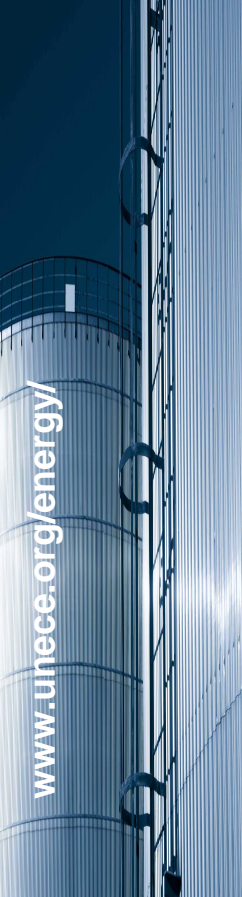
Objective

“Promote an investment climate in which self-sustaining energy efficiency and renewable energy projects can be identified, developed, financed and implemented by local teams in municipalities, factories and energy utilities”



Expected Accomplishments

1. Identify and develop investment projects in the private and public sectors at the local level
2. Strengthen energy efficiency and renewable energy policies, assisting municipal authorities and national administrations
3. Promote opportunities for banks and commercial companies to invest in EE and RE projects through investment funds
