Referring to the Letter from the Chair of the Implementation Committee under the Espoo Convention (see attachment) I can give you following clarification:

I suppose the answer to question 32 is based on a misunderstanding for my part. I interpreted the "decision-making process" as a process going on on the side of those who are responsible for the activity in terms of a sensitisation to environmental matters. In fact the EIA Procedure influences the decision-making process very much. The final decision as it is mentioned in art. 6 is done by the government of Liechtenstein. This decision is based on the summary of the office of environmental protection (art. 16. para.1 of our eia-law) and the comments and requirements of other affected offices. The summary itself includes the important aspects of the the environmental impact assessment documentation, the comments and requirements of NGO's and all affected offices. The announcement of the summary and the final decision takes place in the local newspapers and they are accesible for the public.
