**Re: Communications to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by the United Kingdom (Refs. ACCC/C/2010/45 and ACCC/C/2011/60)**

At its thirty-fifth meeting (13-16 December 2011), the Compliance Committee considered the progress on the above-referenced communications. With regard to communication ACCC/C/2010/45 (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland), the Committee recalled that it had initially decided that summary proceedings would apply, but in the meantime, the communicant had considerably expanded the scope of the communication and a number of issues raised related to communication ACCC/C/2011/60 (United Kingdom). The Committee noted that it had invited the Party concerned to respond to these together with its response in communication ACCC/C/2011/60. The Committee agreed that it would decide how to proceed with communications ACCC/C/2010/45 and ACCC/C/2011/60 at its thirty-sixth meeting.

The response of the Party concerned to ACCC/C/2011/60 and the expanded allegations in ACCC/C/2010/45, together with attachments, are enclosed for both communicants' reference with the electronic copy of this letter.
