I have had a brief look at this review file. As I said on the phone there are a number of older cases on hands and the Office is prioritising such cases at present.

In your case, the SEI has claimed many of the exceptions provided for in the AIE Regulations and has provided this office with comprehensive submissions on the matter. These along with your submissions will require detailed consideration and I anticipate it will take some time to complete the review. It is not possible to assess how much time will be required at this stage. I appreciate that this may not be very satisfactory for you. If you wish to send in something to me as to why you consider your appeal should be dealt with as soon as possible, please do so and I will bring it to the attention of the Senior Investigator.
