Dear Ms Marshall,

I enclose below my response to Ireland's reply of 29<sup>th</sup> September 2015.

I am not sure what the rules are , of if there are any strict rules, regarding replying to a party's response.

However, I think it is necessary to reply in detail in writing, as Ireland's response has brought up many new points, as well as seeking to claim that I have not exhausted my domestic remedies. If a hearing is to be scheduled for December, then the time usually allocated would not be adequate to rebut all of the issues raised by Ireland. I hope therefore, that it is possible for my reply to made available to the ACCC before any scheduled hearing. Of course, I understand that Ireland may also wish to reply to my reply, noting that they stated that they retained to right to make further clarifications, in their response.
