In accordance with the relevant procedures, the Committee is expected to consider any submission made by a Party concerning another Party's compliance with its obligations under the Convention, as provided for under paragraph 15 of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties (ECE/MP.PP/2/Add.8).

5. Submissions by Parties concerning their own compliance

In accordance with the relevant procedures, the Committee is expected to consider any submission made by a Party concerning its own compliance with the obligations under the Convention, as provided for under decision I/7, annex, paragraph 16.

The Committee is expected to consider, in accordance with the relevant procedures, any referrals made by the secretariat concerning possible non-compliance by individual Parties with their obligations under the Convention, as provided for under decision I/7, annex, paragraph 17.

7. Communications from members of the public

In accordance with the relevant procedures, the Committee is mandated to consider communications from the public, as provided for under decision I/7, annex, chapter VI.

(a) The Committee is expected to finalize and adopt its findings and, as appropriate, recommendations with regard to communications ACCC/C/2008/23 (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland), ACCC/C/2008/27 (United Kingdom), ACCC/C/2008/33 (United Kingdom) and ACCC/C/2009/37 (Belarus), taking into account comments received from the Parties concerned and the communicants;

(b) The Committee is expected to continue its deliberations on communications ACCC/C/2008/32 (European Union), ACCC/C/2009/38 (United Kingdom), ACCC/C/2009/41 (Slovakia) and ACCC/C/2009/43 (Armenia) in closed sessions with a view to completing its preparation of draft findings and, if appropriate, recommendations;

(c) The Committee is expected to discuss the substance of communication ACCC/C/2009/44 (Belarus). In accordance with decision I/7, annex, chapter IX, paragraph 32, the Party concerned and the communicant are entitled to participate in the discussion on the subject matter of the communication;

(d) The Committee is expected to consider any new information received with regard to communications ACCC/C/2008/28 (Denmark) and ACCC/C/2008/31 (Germany);

(e) The Committee is also expected to consider any new information received with regard to communication ACCC/C/2010/48 (Austria) and to discuss how to proceed with this communication, including the possible timing of discussions on the substance of the case;

(f) The Committee will discuss any new communications received sufficiently in advance of the meeting, in particular with respect to their admissibility and any issues that may need to be raised with the Party concerned or the communicant;

(g) The Committee may discuss any other issues related to other communications, especially communications ACCC/C/2010/45 and ACCC/C/2010/49.

8. Reporting requirements

In the light of its mandate under decision I/7, annex, paragraph 13 (c), the Committee is expected to consider matters related to the implementation of decision III/5 on reporting requirements (ECE/MP.PP/2008/2/Add.7) and the procedures for the preparation by Parties of their implementation reports for the fourth session of the Meeting of the Parties.

9. Matters arising from the decisions of the Meeting of the Parties, including follow-up on specific cases of non-compliance

The Committee will be invited to discuss any progress with regard to implementation of decisions III/6 and III/6a-f. The Committee will in particular consider any information received from the Governments of Albania, Armenia, Lithuania, Turkmenistan and Ukraine with regard to implementation of decisions III/6a, III/6b, III/6d, III/6e and III/6f, respectively.
