**Re: Decision III/6d of the Meeting of the Parties to the Aarhus Convention concerning compliance by Lithuania with its obligations under the Convention**

Hereby I would like to draw your attention to decision III/6d adopted by the Parties to the Aarhus Convention at their third meeting on 13 June 2008 in Riga, Latvia, concerning compliance by Lithuania with its obligations under the Convention (ECE/MP.PP/2008/2/Add.12). The decision was adopted in accordance with article 15 of the Convention and decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties on review of compliance. An advance copy of decision III/6d is enclosed.

The report of the third meeting of the Parties (ECE/MP.PP/2008/2) and its addenda are available on the website ([www.unece.org/env/pp/mop3/mop3.docv.htm](http://www.unece.org/env/pp/mop3/mop3.docv.htm)).

The Compliance Committee at its twenty-first meeting (17-19 September 2008) considered the decisions of the third meeting of the Parties concerning compliance by individual Parties, inter alia, in connection with its obligation to report on their implementation to the next meeting of the Parties. The Committee requested the secretariat to send a reminder to each of the Parties concerned, highlighting, in particular, the relevant deadlines and the kinds of information to be provided to the Committee.

In this regard, I would like to draw your attention to paragraph 3 of decision III/6d through which the Meeting of the Parties requested the Government of Lithuania to draw up an action plan for implementing recommendations set out in paragraph 2 of the decision, with the involvement of the public concerned, and to submit it to the Committee by 31 December 2008. You are therefore invited to provide to the Committee the relevant information by that date.

The Meeting also invited the Government of Lithuania to provide information to the Committee at the latest six months in advance of the fourth meeting of the Parties on the measures taken and the results achieved in implementation of the recommendations.
