**Re: Information provided by Ukraine on Romania's activities in the Danube Delta**

Thank you for your letter of 10 August 2009 and enclosures, which as per your request were brought to the attention of the Committee at its twenty-fifth meeting (Geneva, 22-25 September 2009). The Committee duly took note of the information so provided. The relevant excerpt of the report of the meeting reads:

"The secretariat informed the Committee of information provided for the Committee's consideration on 13 August 2009 by the Government of Ukraine regarding various industrial activities by Romania in the Danube delta area. The Ukrainian Mission had subsequently clarified, at the request of the secretariat, that the correspondence was not to be construed as a submission by a Party concerning another Party pursuant to paragraph 15 of the annex to decision I/7 (ECE/MP.PP/2/Add.8). The Committee took note of the information provided."
