Regarding question n.1:

a. The process is actually being reviewed registered to the Administrative Court of Appeals on September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2016. It has been randomly chosen by computer ballot system and the judge who has been selected to review it is Rilinda Selimi.

b. Up to the present date no request for suspension about the above mentioned case has been registered by the Administrative Court of Appeals.

c. The Administrative Court of Appeals is still reviewing registered cases dating back to 2014, due to the high volume of judicial cases and an exact case has not been set yet by the relating judge.

d. The planning falls under the competence of the relating judge and up to the present moment there is no set date. The cases that are being reviewed date back to 2014 and every case must wait for its turn according to the existing rule. There is no request for a speedy trial from the sides in question. If there would be a case of request for a speedy trial, it is up to the relating judges to decide and satisfy it or not.

Regarding question n.2: Yes, the decision of the Court of Appeal can be appealed to the Supreme Court of Albania. The time frame of the court to decide on a given case ranges between 1-2 years.
