

## Alistair McGlone

### Supplementary information on current responsibilities

Since leaving the UK civil service I have been a director of Alistair McGlone and Associates Ltd, a consultancy that focuses on environmental law, training and journalism. My responsibilities have included the following:

- I have worked for the Secretariat of the Basel Convention on transboundary movement of waste to prepare, for the Implementation Committee (a) a revised draft of the **Basel Implementation Manual**, which, after approval by the Conference of the Parties, will provide a comprehensive resource explaining rights and obligations under the Convention; and (b) an extensive **strategy** for the Committee **to promote full legislative implementation of the Convention**.
- As an advisor to the **Montreal Protocol's Technical and Economic Assessment Panel (TEAP)** I led the revision of the TEAP's operating procedures, synthesised conflict of interest provisions, and mediated disputes within the Panel. I have also interviewed key stakeholders (Parties, civil society and international bodies) to prepare the report of the **Replenishment Task Force** that has advised the international community on spending around \$1.5bn to phase out production and consumption of ozone depleting substances; I was lead author of a chapter of the report.
- I am the chair of the compliance committee of the **UNECE PRTR Protocol**; we have agreed our modus operandi and I was the lead author of the committee's synthesis report, which will be presented to the Protocol Parties tomorrow.
- As a member of the public international law panel of the **British Institute of International and Comparative Law**, I have contributed to BIICL's overall engagement with the subject; I have also spoken at Institute events, particularly on implementation of, and compliance with, international environmental law.
- I work in partnership with **the Centre for Political and Diplomatic Studies** to train UK and Australian officials for international negotiations.
- I have published articles on the **Channel 4 website on climate change**.
- I am a reviewer for the Access Initiative's new online platform – **Environmental Democracy Index**, which measures how well national laws of 75 countries harmonize with the UNEP Bali Guidelines on Principle 10 against 99 indicators.
