## What is a project about?

The growth of green urban development plans and pilot green urban development initiatives related to energy efficiency and sustainable transport in small and medium cities in Belarus

### It is expected:

- to generate lifetime direct GHG emission reductions of 77.8 ktonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent through improved urban transport efficiencies in the cities of Polotsk and Novopolotsk
- and 13.3 ktonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent through energy efficiency pilots in Novogrudok municipality
- indirect emission reductions (top-down and bottom-up) will range from 25.2 to 231 ktonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent

- Development and adoption of green urban development plans
- Development of pilots on sustainable urban transport in Novopolotsk and Polotsk
- Development of pilots on energy efficiency in Novogrudok
- Replication mechanisms for green urban development in Belarus
