

## Workshop on validation of results of mapping of technologies to enhance energy efficiency in buildings Third Meeting of the Joint Task Force on Energy Efficiency Standards in Buildings

## **BACKGROUND NOTE**

To address the issue of improving energy efficiency in buildings, the UNECE Committee on Housing and Land Management and Committee on Sustainable Energy established the <u>Joint Task Force on Energy Efficiency Standards in Buildings</u> in 2015 and extended its mandate for further two years in 2017. Since 2017, UNECE has been implementing <u>two projects</u> funded by the Governments of Denmark and the Russian Federation to assist with the implementation of activities of the Joint Task Force.

The <u>first meeting of the Joint Task Force</u> was organized on 30-31 October 2017 with the aim to operationalize the Joint Task Force and to discuss the approaches to a study on mapping existing energy efficiency standards in buildings in the UNECE region, which is the first output of the project. The <u>second meeting of the Joint Task Force</u> took place in Yerevan, Armenia on 14-15 May 2018 to review a draft of the study on mapping energy efficiency standards in buildings in the UNECE region and validate its results. The study on mapping energy efficiency standards in buildings in the UNECE region is currently in the final stages of finalization and will be available on our <u>website</u> in English and Russian.

This workshop aims to review a draft of the study on mapping of existing technologies to enhance energy efficiency in buildings, including gap analysis and recommendations for their use in the region and validate its results, to discuss the status of development and implementation of energy efficient technologies in buildings in UNECE member States, exchange experiences in implementation of advanced technologies, and to discuss the next steps in the implementation of the activities of the Joint Task Force.



The meeting will be held back-to-back with the <u>79th session of the Committee on Housing and Land Management</u> on 4-5 October 2018. During this session, a roundtable on "Promoting access to decent, adequate, affordable and healthy housing for all" will be organized on 4 October.
