# Panel discussion "Improving housing affordability in the UNECE Region"

The UNECE Committee on Urban Development, Housing and Land Management at its eightieth session invited the Bureau to develop the study "#Housing 2030 - Improving Housing Affordability in the UNECE region" in cooperation with UN-Habitat and Housing Europe and reiterated its request made at its seventy-ninth session in 2018 to conduct a survey of member States to identify their challenges and priorities in relation to housing affordability. The Committee will be informed on progress made in the development of the study and will be invited to discuss its preliminary findings.

Representatives of the countries will exchange experiences and lessons learned in addressing challenges of the housing affordability.

The meeting is part of the 81st session of the UNECE Committee on Urban Development, Housing and Land Management. It will take place in a hybrid mode (in-person at the Palais des Nations in Geneva and online) with simultaneous translation in three languages – English, French and Russian.
