And according to the mandate, REM will:

- In cooperation with the Committee on Urban Development, Housing and Land Management and the Working Party on Land Administration,
  - (a) **Organize**, **international workshops and side events** that will promote the implementation of the Committee's and the Working Party's programmes of work and **the dissemination of information** about the Committee and Working Party's activities, including on the Geneva UN Charter on Sustainable Housing;
  - (b) **Prepare studies** under the above-mentioned thematic priorities
  - (c) Support the information dissemination of information about the Committee's and Working Party's activities, including on the Geneva UN Charter on Sustainable Housing, on the Charter through presentations at international meetings, and the preparation of articles in books, journals and mass media, including social media;



### Program Work activities 2021-2022

(ECE/HBP/2020/5)

#### **REM also** will:

- (a) Participate in the Committee's activities on energy efficient and affordable housing, especially in support of the Economic Commission for Europe "#Housing 2030: Improving Housing Affordability in the UNECE region" study and the ECE Joint Task Force on Energy Efficiency Standards in Buildings;
- (b) Provide input into the Committee's activities on smart sustainable cities, including the development of smart sustainable city indicators and standards, the preparation of smart sustainable city profiles and cities action plans.
  - (a) The REM Advisory Group members will **participate in related events and capacity building workshops** and will also support the ECE secretariat with fundraising for future activities under this topic.
  - (b) They will also participate in activities of **the Initiative** "**United for Smart Sustainable Cities**".



## Programme 2021-2022. Planned activities

#### Associated to Housing 2030 project about affordable housing

- a.- Fuel poverty and policies to promote energy efficiency in affordable housing.
- b.- Housing for elderly citizens: the role of senior housing as affordable housing. This topic could include 'Housing for all, integrating the needs and aspirations of all groups, including young and old, and people with physical and cognitive impairments (e.g. 'living with dementia').
- c.- The **estimation of lack of affordability** at the country/region level in the EU-countries.
- d.- Housing affordability **from the legal perspective**. Potential regulatory solutions to afford a house.



## Programme 2021-2022. Planned activities

#### Associated to Smart and Sustainable Cities (U4SSC):

- a.- The use of land in urban contexts, bringing brownfield land into use, revitalizing neighbourhoods, finding new uses for old buildings and infrastructure, and neighbourhood revitalization.
- b.- Working with communities, building sustainable neighbourhoods in deprived areas, and community based master planning. (refers to land planning and regulatory design).
- c.- Green solutions, carbon-neutral, fossil fuel-free, low energy housing.
- d.-"An advice to the CUDHLM's Board on a contribution to "Decade of Actions to SDGs" and to EU Green Deal. A monitor the urban progress in reaching SDGs
- e.- Heritage buildings, lead
- f.- Finance solutions for affordable housing and sustainable cities: finance mechanism ... Housing finance study



## Programme 2021-2022. Planned activities

#### III.- Property Administration and Management specific topics

- a.- "The role and implementation of the **technologies for better** administration and improvement of the Real Estate Market, all included processes and connected people.
- b.- A proposal of **training progress related to** any aspect treated in the 'Guidelines on the Management and Ownership of Condominium Housing'.
