










Structural model of urban economic resilience

Post COVID-19 Recovery in Informal Settlements in the ECE Region



Overall objective

 To strengthen the capacity of the national and local governments in the UNECE countries to address the needs of the most vulnerable groups of population living in the informal settlements.

Rationale

- Integrate informal constructions into formal land markets to provide clear ownership and security of tenure and through this enhance economic security of residents.
- **Upgrade and connect** informal and newly formalized settlements **with basic services and infrastructure** to safeguard residents against future pandemics.

Project Activities

- Post COVID-19 Recovery Action Plan for Informal Settlements for countries in the ECE region
- Concrete recommendations for the pilot cities –
 Bishkek, Podgorica, Skopje and Tirana for upgrading
 the informal settlements and supporting the cities in
 the recovery from COVID-19 pandemic
- Building capacity through a series of online lectures and workshops on Recovery Action Plan
