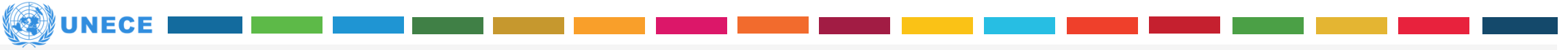

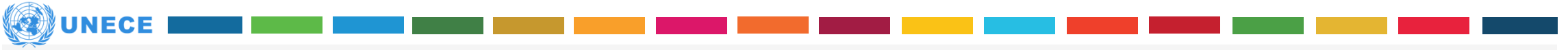

A joint study with Housing Europe and UN-Habitat
“#Housing2030 - Improving Housing Affordability in the UNECE region”

The objectives of the study are to:

- i. Explore housing affordability challenges and existing policy instruments for improving housing affordability in the UNECE region;
- ii. Facilitate the exchange and dissemination of “good practices” in improving housing affordability among countries and cities of the UNECE region;
- iii. Identify needs of policymakers to further develop and implement policies addressing housing affordability.

Planned / ongoing activity 2020-2022 under the Joint Task Force on energy efficiency in buildings

Gap analysis between the performance objectives set forth in the Framework Guidelines and current energy efficiency standards and their implementation in the countries of South-Eastern and Eastern Europe, the Caucasus, Central Asia, and in the Russian Federation.

National studies for the three selected ECE member States with a more detailed gap analysis.

Maintenance of the network of experts on energy efficiency in buildings in the ECE region.

Workshop for stakeholders to validate the gap analysis. Seminars in the selected ECE member States on high-performance energy efficiency standards. Workshop for stakeholders to discuss and launch the studies.

Impact discovery on how member States could better use best practices and guidelines in national or/and sub-national measures to address the issues of energy efficiency in buildings.

Funding provided only to UNECE Sustainable Energy Division from the extrabudgetary project (funded by the Russian Federation) “Enhancing national capacities to develop and implement energy efficiency standards for buildings in the UNECE region” for the period of July 2020 – March 2022
