
Regional Advisor – Transport

For much of his career, Mr. Nikolic work has focused on the development of efficient multimodal regional transport networks, transport connectivity and the improvement of road safety. As a regional advisor, he is providing a broad range of capacity development services to the member States on sustainable transport, road safety and connectivity. He is involved in regional infrastructure development projects (TEM, TER), regional sustainable transport and connectivity cooperation in Central Asia (SPECA) and road safety development projects. Prior to joining UNECE in 2014, Mr. Nikolic was General Manager and Transport Planning Manager at the South-East Europe Transport Observatory (SEETO), and Head of Unit at the Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Serbia. He graduated from the Transport and Traffic Engineering Faculty and is now finalizing his PhD studies in Road Safety at the University of Belgrade. Mr. Nikolic has published more than 40 papers in various areas of transport planning, road safety and intelligent transport systems.
