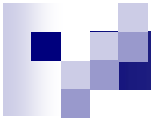

- Having problems with accommodation



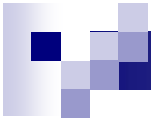
Tasks of Host Family

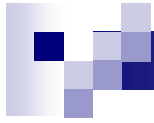
- To act as the contact persons
