### **Poverty indicators for monitoring SDG in the CIS region**

#### **Abstract**

The report will provide a brief overview of the status of the implementation of the SDG indicators on poverty and inequality in the statistical practice of the countries of the Commonwealth of Independent States:

- analyzed indicators of poverty and inequality, included in the national list of indicators of achievement of the SDG from the point of view of their comparability;
- the practice of the CIS countries on data disaggregation (by sex, age groups, place of residence, individual socio-demographic groups that are most at risk of poverty) is presented.

CIS-Stat will also present its own experience in monitoring the achievement of the SDG in the CIS region in terms of poverty and inequality in the context of social groups such as children, youth, older people, people with disabilities. Problems of monitoring will also be identified: data inconsistency, different approaches to disaggregation, unavailability of information, etc.
