


- Data integration



#### **Supporting Standards Group**



- Support implementation and use of GSBPM, GAMSO, GSIM, CSPA, ..., including:
  - Answering questions and supporting implementers
  - Developing and publishing complementary materials, such as case studies, good practices, etc.
  - Workshops and training to promote and ensure consistent use of the HLG-MOS standards and models
  - Managing periodic reviews of standards and models.
    Next reviews of GSBPM / GSIM are scheduled for 2018
- Take on current work of the MC on Standards, and responsibility for CSPA documentation

#### **Statistical Modernization Community**



- Launched in 2016
- Open to all statistical organisations who endorse "Statement of Intent"
- No fee, but expectation to contribute
- Partners benefit from collaboration and sharing
- Four main principles:
  - Openness
  - Flexibility
