



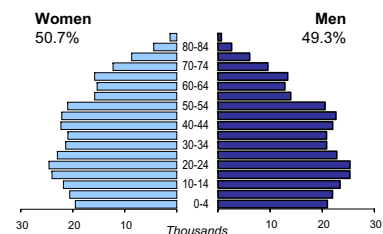

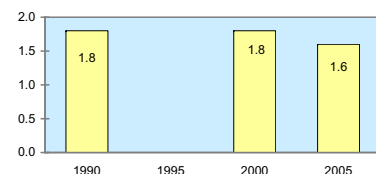

## Total fertility rate



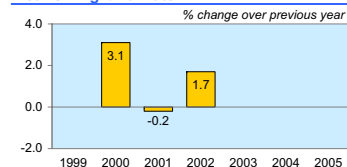

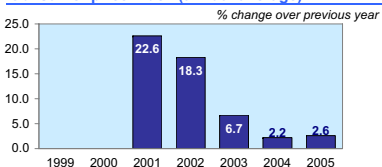

## Real GDP growth rate



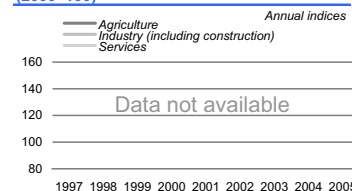
## Consumer price index (annual average)



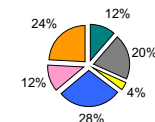

## GDP in agriculture, industry, and services (2000=100)



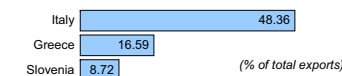
## GDP by major sectors



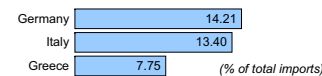
## Employment in major sectors



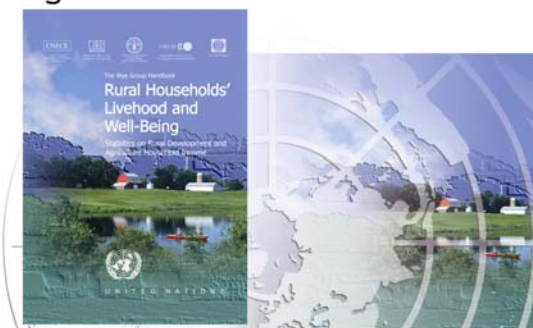
## Major export partners in UNECE, 2005
