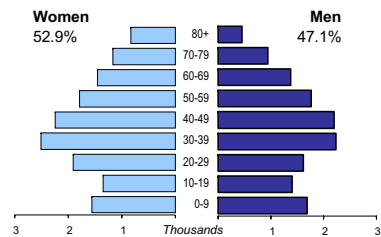

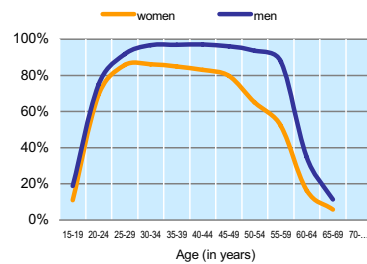

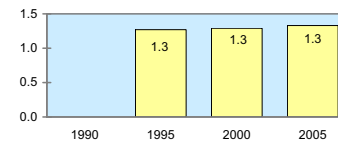

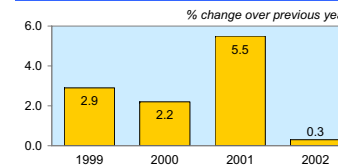

## Total fertility rate



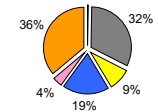
## Real GDP growth rate
