



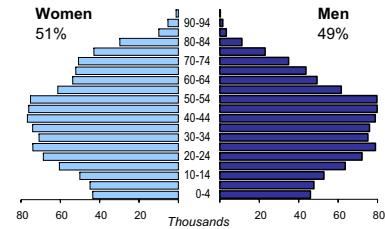

Population by age, 2005

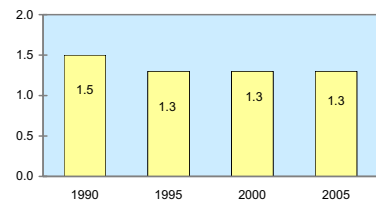

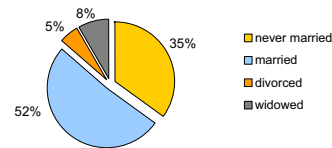

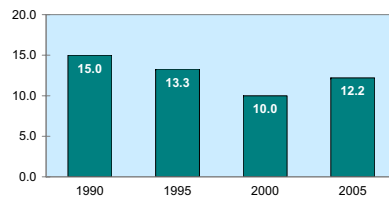


Legal marital status, population aged 18+, 2004

Parliament seats held by women (% of total)

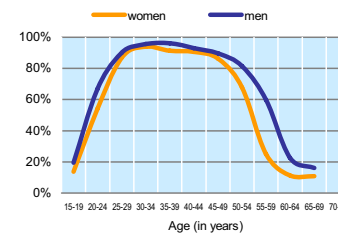

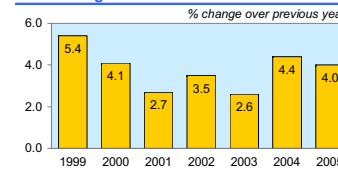

Economic activity rate, 2004

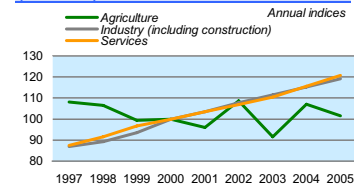


Real GDP growth rate

GDP in agriculture, industry, and services (2000=100)



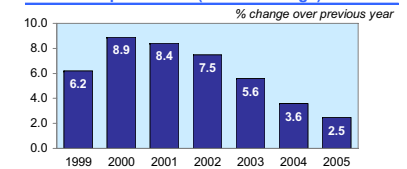

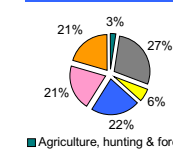

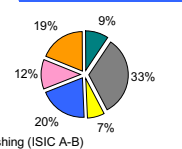
Consumer price index (annual average)
