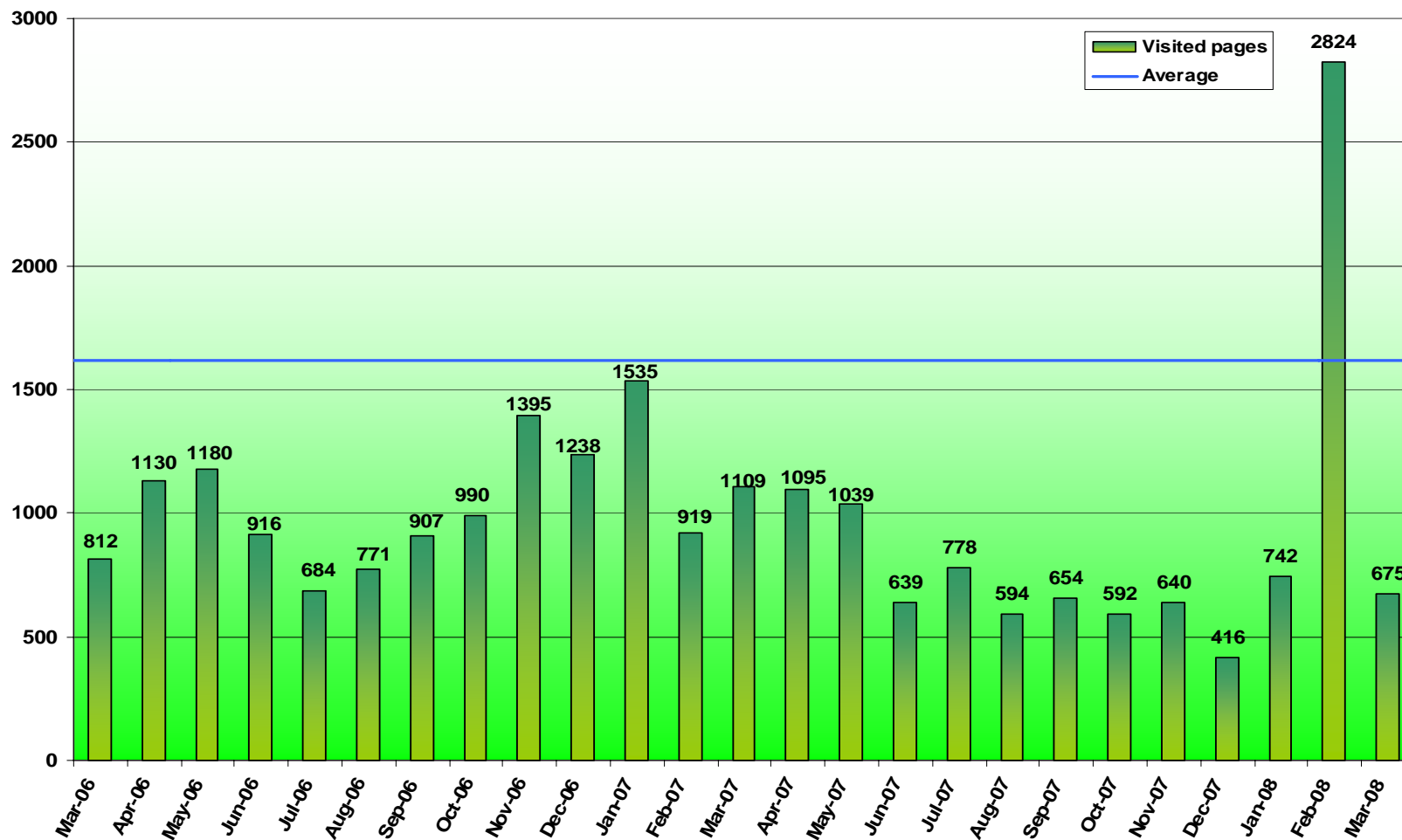

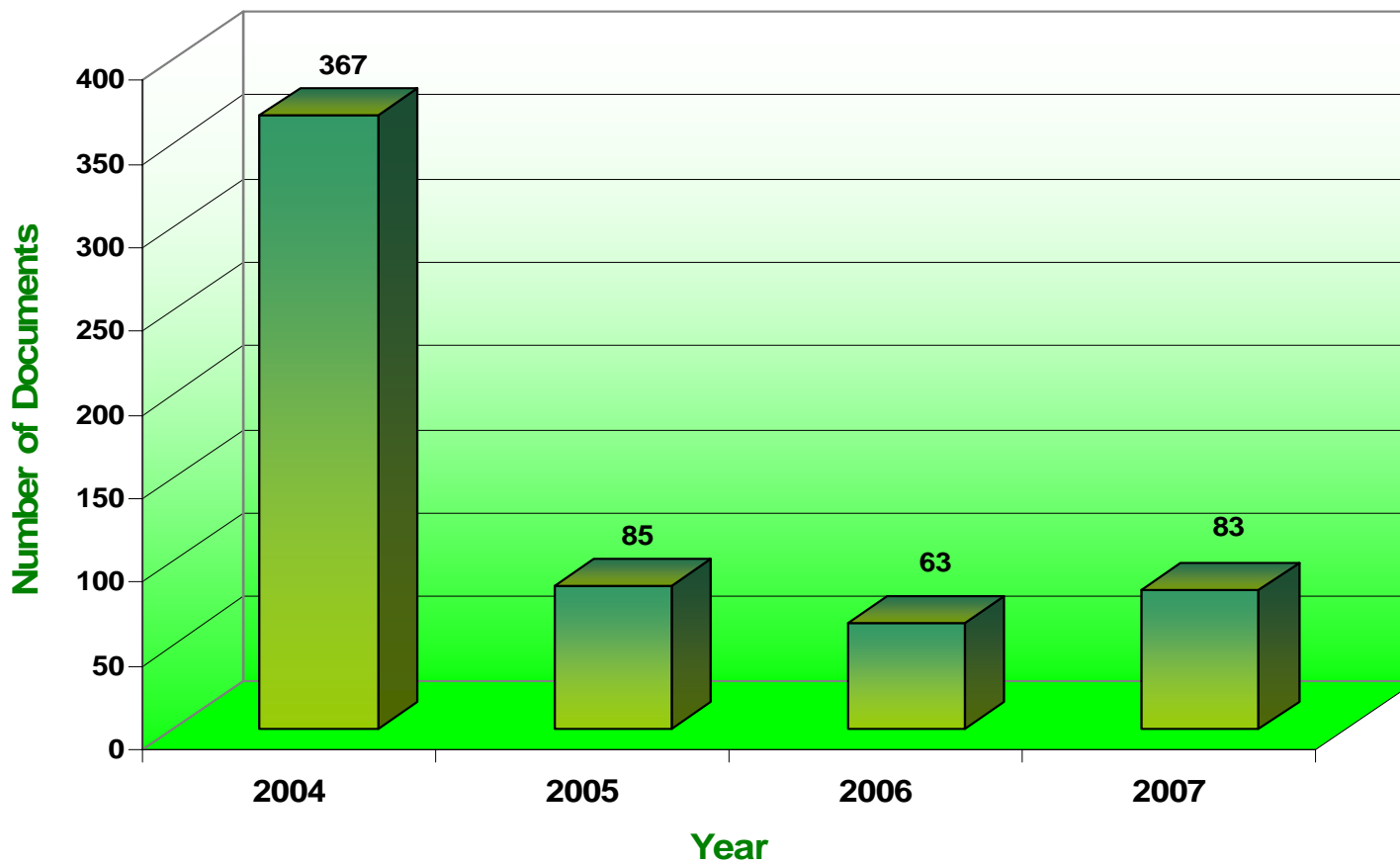

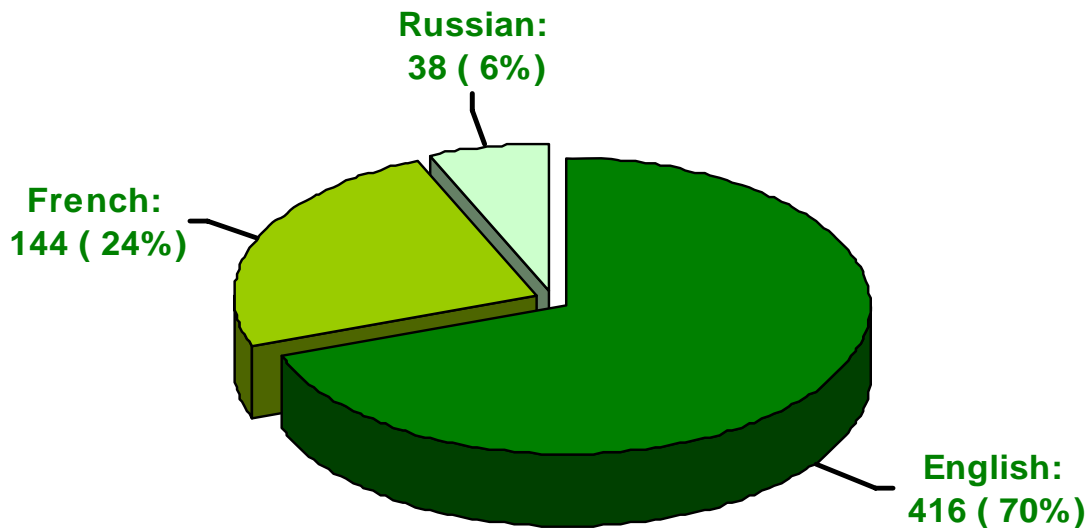
CLEARING HOUSE USE: VISITED PAGES, March 2006 – March 2007



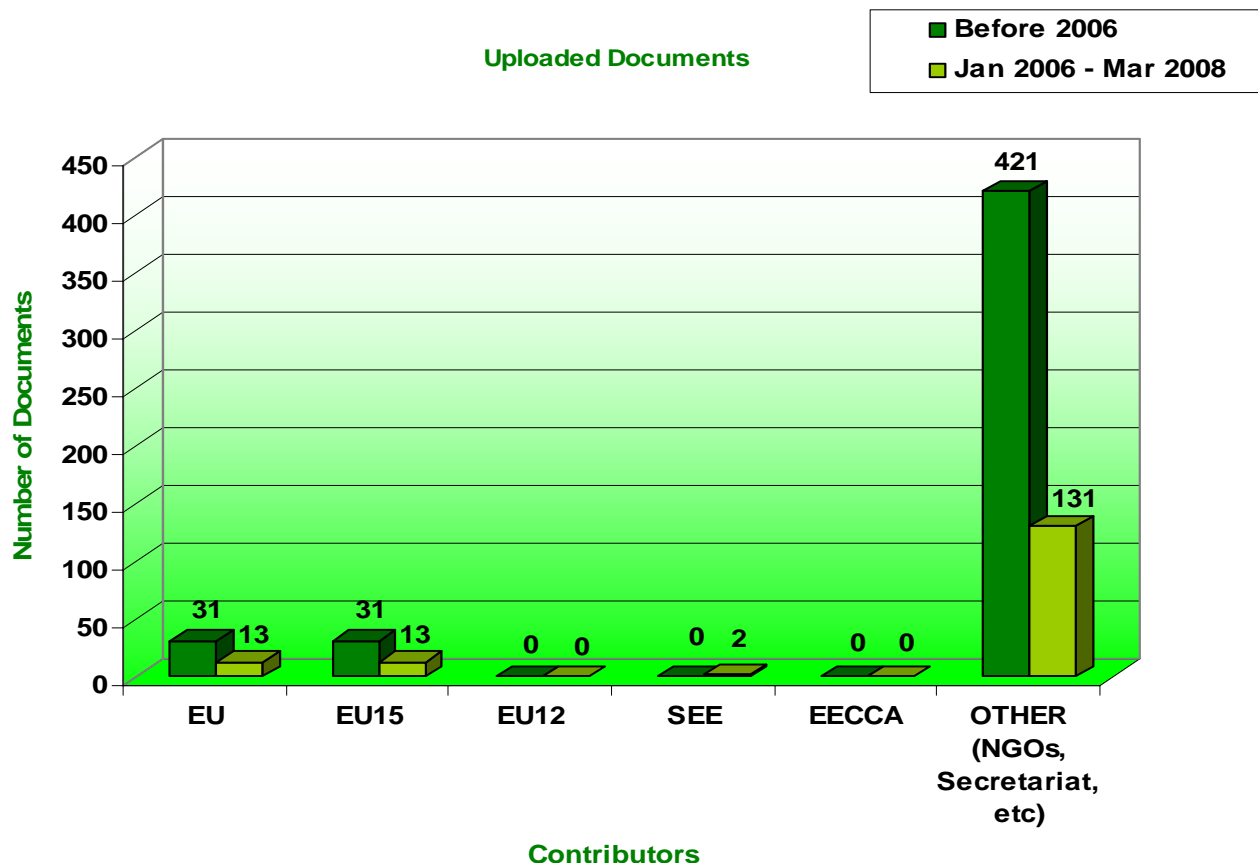
CLEARING HOUSE CONTENT: UPLOADED DOCUMENTS

CLEARING HOUSE CONTENT: CONTRIBUTORS, January 2006 – March 2008



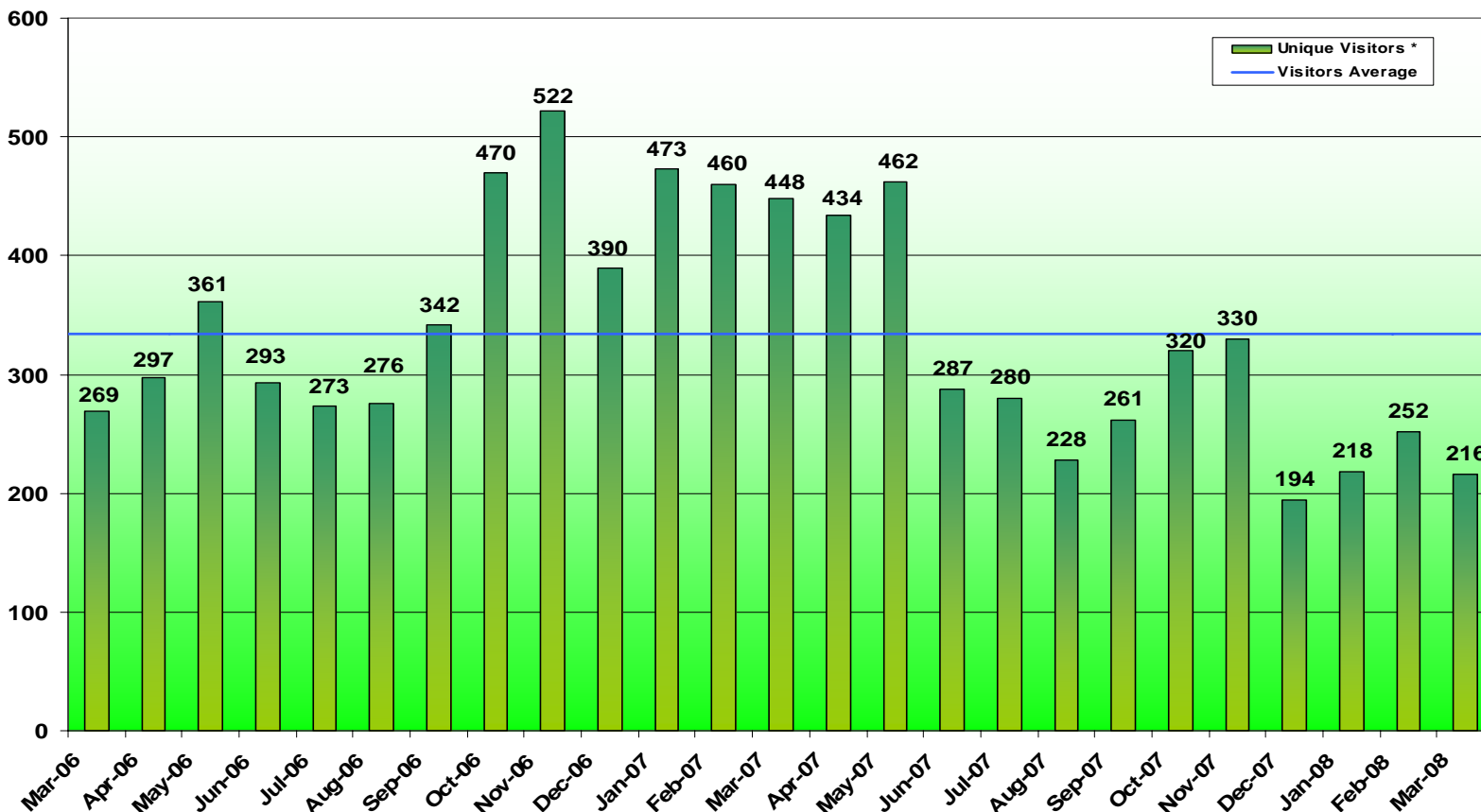

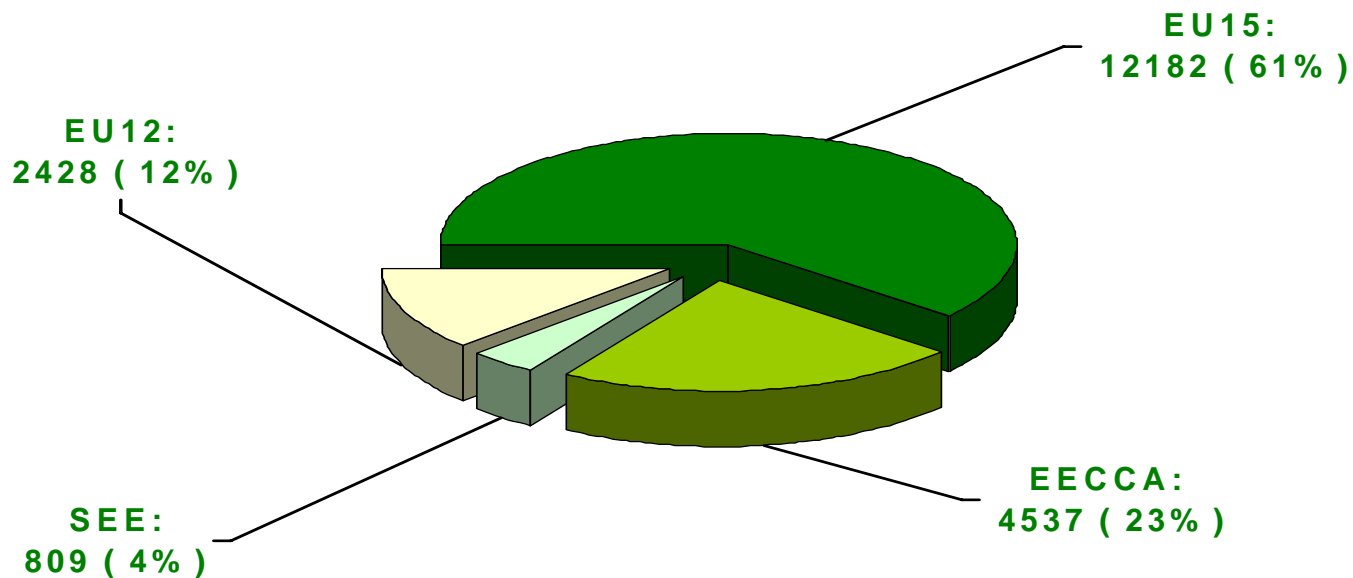
CLEARING HOUSE USE: UNIQUE VISITORS, March 2006 – March 2008



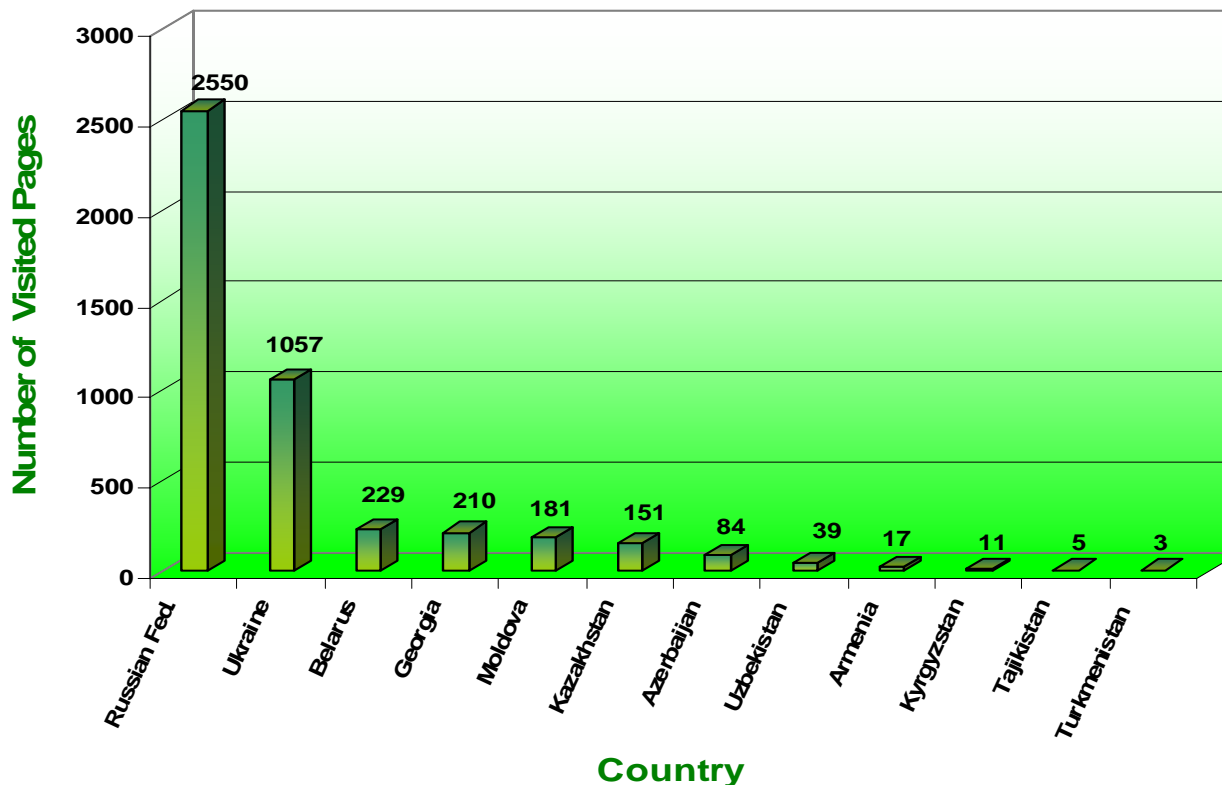
Unique Visitor:

A unique visitor is someone with a unique address who is entering The PEP Clearing House web site and are counted only once per day, no matter how often they visit the site. Unique visitors are measured according to their unique IP addresses, which are like online fingerprints.

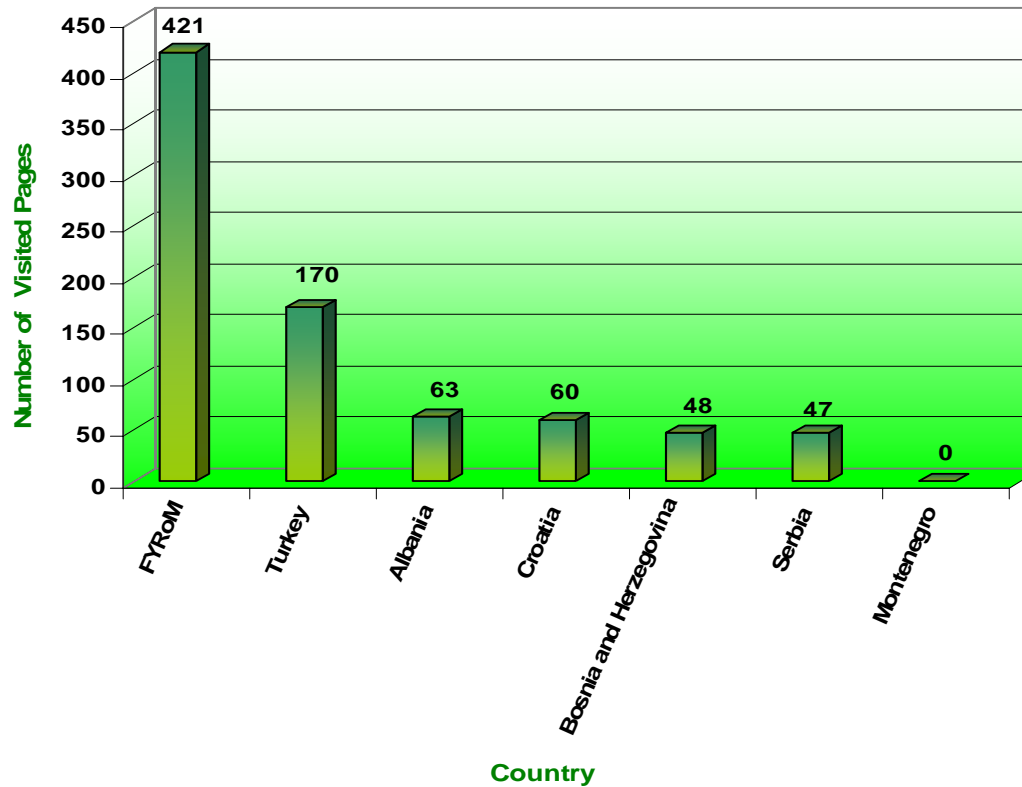
VISITED PAGES PER SUB-REGION/ COUNTRY, March 2006 – March 2008 (EECCA, SEE, EU12, EU15)
