Item 5: Market analysis and forecasts:

The Working Party will be invited to review publications, organisation of market discussions, and the mandate and functions of the proposed team of specialists.

Item 6: Interorganization co-operation on forest and forest products statistics

Delegates will be informed of the activities of the Intersecretariat Working Group on Forest Sector Statistics.

Item 7: Programme of work for 2001-2005

The Working Party will be invited to approve a work programme on the basis of the discussions under other items, as well as the instructions by parent bodies and the resources likely to be available. It will also be briefed on and invited to comment on the results of the strategic review of the integrated ECE/FAO programme of work, and to discuss in more general terms its role in the revised system.

Item 8: Any other business

At the time of writing the secretariat has no matters for discussion under this item.

Item 9: Election of officers

The Working Party is expected to elect a Chairman and two Vice-Chairmen. At its twenty-second session, the Working Party elected Mr. D. Brooks (USA) Chairman and Messrs J. Stolp (the Netherlands) and M. Gecovic (Slovakia) Vice-Chairmen to hold office until the end of the twenty-third session.

Item 10: Adoption of the report

The Working Party will be invited to adopt the report of its session on the basis of a draft prepared by the secretariat.
