ENTRY INTO FORCE OF AMENDMENTS TO ANNEXES 2 AND 7

None of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Convention having expressed an objection by 1 May 1989, the amendments in question, in accordance with the decision of the Administrative Committee, taken at its eleventh session held in Geneva on 24 and 25 November 1988, will enter into force on 1 August 1989.
