## 6. New UNECE standard for edible meat co-products

The Specialized Section will consider the proposal prepared by the Working Group formed by the delegations of Australia, France and the United States on a new UNECE standard for edible meat co-products, also often referred to as offal, fancy meats, variety meats and edible by-products. The participants will be invited to review the draft and propose changes/amendments and decide whether the text should be submitted to the Working Party for approval.

#### 7. New UNECE standard for duck meat – carcases and parts

<u>Documentation:</u> Draft new UNECE standard for duck meat – carcasses and parts

The delegation of China will present the draft of the standard discussed at the November rapporteurs' meeting in Moscow. The Specialized Section is expected to finalize the text and recommend it to the Working Party for approval.
