Dear Multiplier Point Representatives,

We would like to inform you about the three new UNECE transport related publications, which are shortly described below. Please note that they are freely available at the UNECE web site: <http://www.unece.org/trans/main/wp6/transstatpub.html>.

1) Annual Bulletin of Statistics of Road Traffic Accidents in Europe and North America: this trilingual (English, French and Russian) publication presents the overall situation and developments regarding road traffic accidents and casualties in the UNECE countries. It provides detailed statistics on road traffic accidents and includes specific circumstances of accidents such as location, time of occurrence, road condition, personal injuries and deaths, as well as accidents provoked by the influence of alcohol.

2) Annual Bulletin of Transport Statistics for Europe and North America: this trilingual (English, French and Russian) publication provides basic data for the UNECE region on transport activity, equipment and infrastructure by mode (rail, road, inland waterway, maritime, intermodal and oil pipeline). General information on population, energy consumption in transport and on road traffic accidents is also provided.

3) Handbook of Transport Statistics in the UNECE Region 2005: this booklet provides, in a handy and easy reference format, selected data on the transport sector of most UNECE member countries. It contains data on the vehicle fleet and rolling stock, traffic volume by mode and road accidents. It also compiles for each country the length of motorways and roads, as well as rail lines and inland waterways.
