ATTENDANCE

1. The Administrative Committee held its sixth session in Geneva on 5 and 6 February 2004.
2. The session was attended by representatives of the following Contracting Parties: Austria; Belarus; Belgium; Bulgaria; Croatia; Czech Republic; Estonia; Finland; France; Germany; Greece; Hungary; Italy; Latvia; Lithuania; Netherlands; Norway; Poland; Romania; Russian Federation; Slovakia; Spain; Sweden; Switzerland; The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia; United Kingdom; European Community (EC).
3. The Administrative Committee noted that the required quorum according to Annex 7, Article 6 of the Convention has been attained.
4. The following non-governmental organization was represented as observer: International Road Transport Union (IRU).

ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

5. The Administrative Committee decided to postpone its considerations of a new draft Annex 8 to the Convention on the facilitation of border crossing procedures for international road transport since several Contracting Parties indicated that they were not yet in a position to decide on the proposal.

6. The Administrative Committee was informed that, at present, the Convention had 44 Contracting Parties, including the European Community. As of 18 March 2004, the Convention will enter into force for Latvia in accordance with the accession of Latvia (Depository Notification C.N.1533.2003.TREATIES-3). The deadline for submission of official documentation is 28 July 2004.
