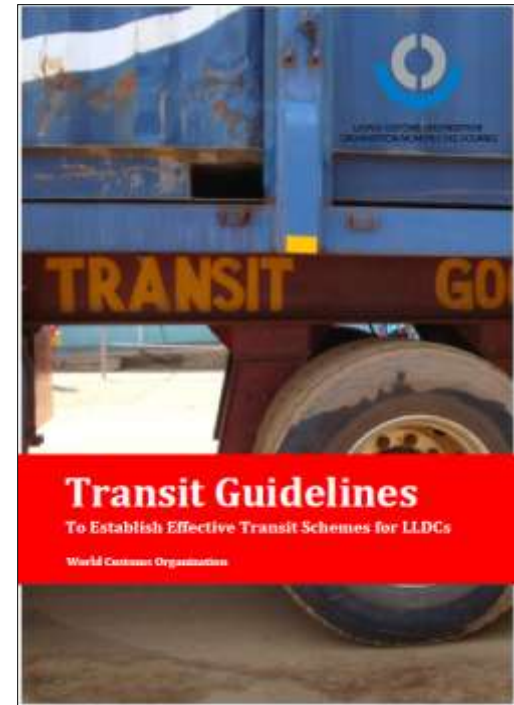
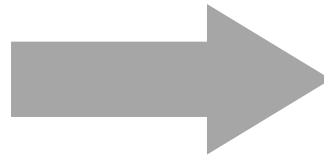
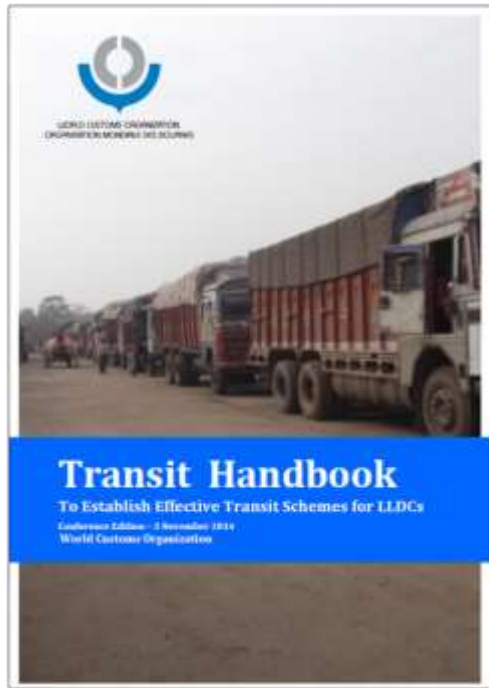

Transit Guidelines



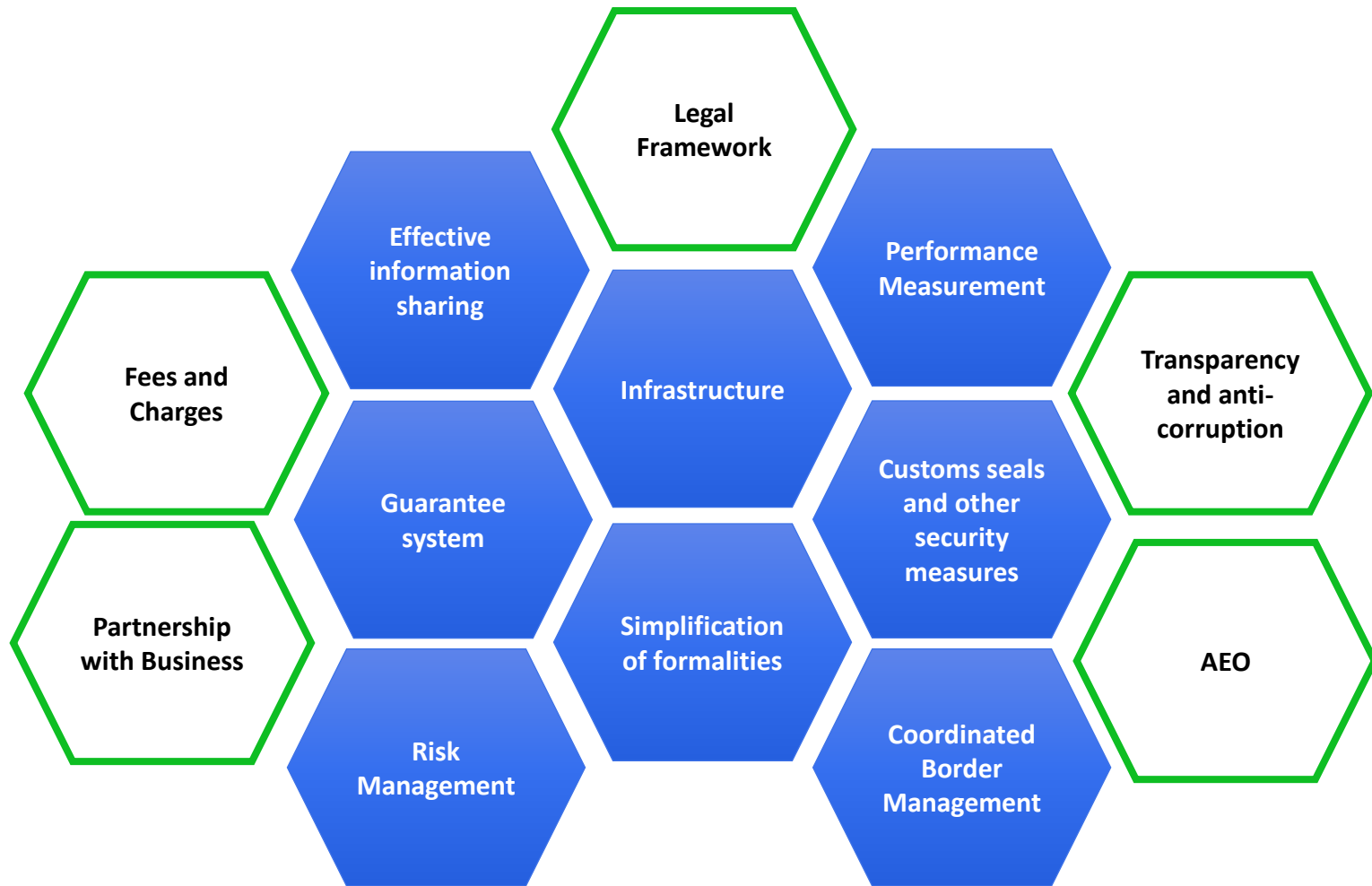
The WCO will develop **new guidelines for transit** based on the Transit Handbook.

Steps for Transit Guidelines

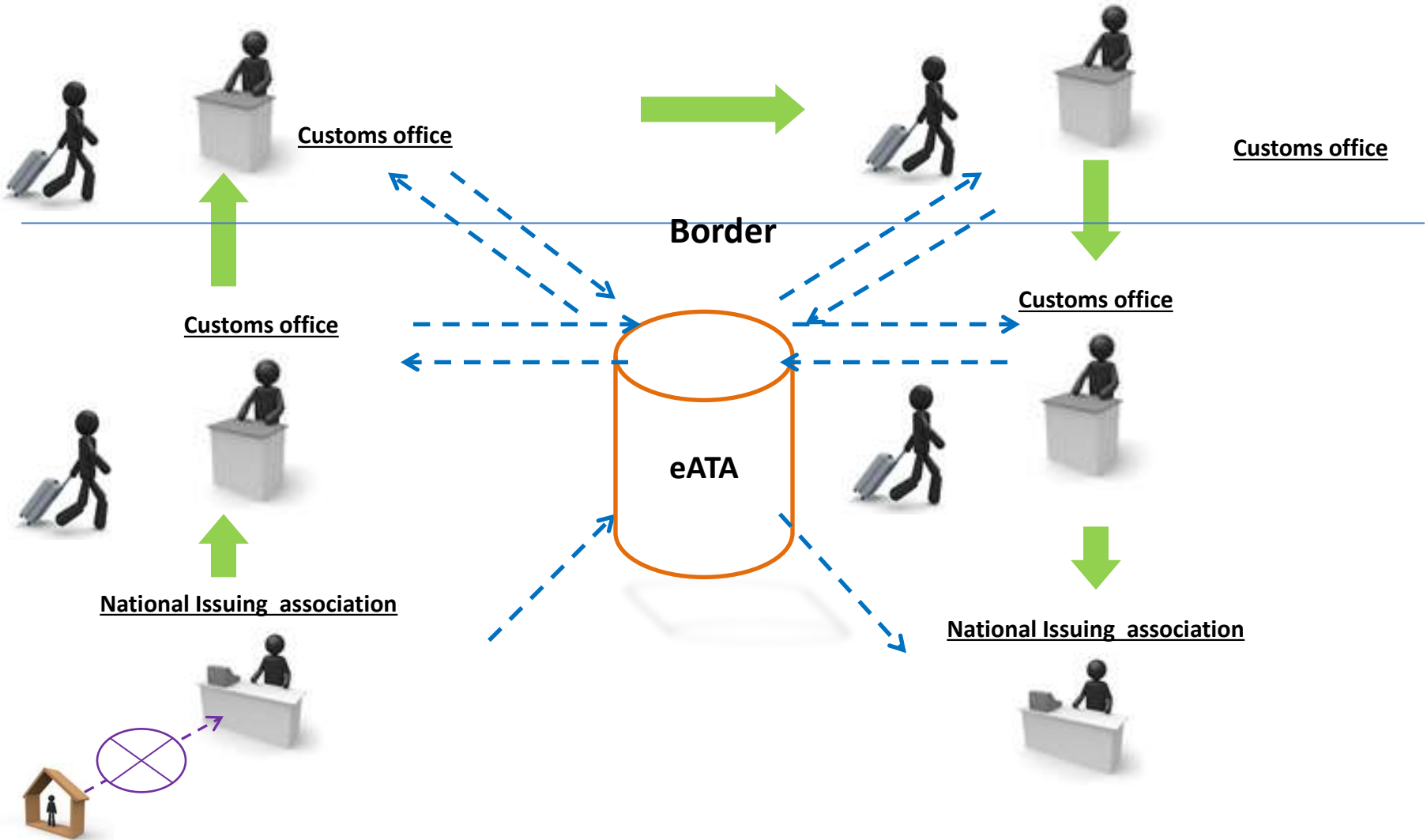
