ACCEPTANCE OF AMENDMENT TO ANNEX I TO THE AGC AGREEMENT¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.532.2007.TREATIES-1 of 3 May 2007 concerning the amendment proposed by the Government of Hungary to Annex I of the AGC Agreement, communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the date of the above communication, none of the Contracting Parties to the AGC Agreement expressed an objection. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 4 of article 11 of the AGC Agreement, the amendment is deemed to be accepted.

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 5 of article 11 of the AGC Agreement, the amendment shall enter into force for all Contracting Parties three months after the expiry of a period of six months following the date of its communication, i.e., on 3 February 2008.
