



**Multilateral agreement M-265 under section 1.5.1 of the ADR,
concerning special provision S12**

- (1) By derogation from the provisions of S12, chapter 8.5 of ADR, the following conditions shall apply for the carriage of UN 2915 RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, TYPE A PACKAGE, and UN 3332, RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, TYPE A PACKAGE, SPECIAL FORM:

“If the total number of packages containing radioactive material carried does not exceed 10, and the sum of the transport indices does not exceed 3, the requirement in 8.2.1 concerning training for drivers of vehicles carrying radioactive material need not be applied. However, drivers shall then receive appropriate training, commensurate with and appropriate to their duties, which provides them with an awareness of the radiation hazards involved in the carriage of radioactive material. Such awareness training shall be confirmed by a certificate provided by their employer.”

- (2) All other relevant provisions of ADR shall be complied with.

- (3) This agreement shall be valid until 1 January 2015 for the carriage on the territories of those ADR Contracting Parties signatory to this agreement. If it is revoked before then by one of the signatories, it shall remain valid until the above mentioned date only for carriage on the territories of those ADR Contracting Parties signatory to this agreement which have not revoked it.
