## Insert new paragraphs 10.4. to 10.6., to read:

- "10.4. No new type approval shall be granted under this Regulation after [36] months after the date of entry into force of the 01 series of amendments to Regulation No. 107.
- 10.5. Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall not refuse to grant extensions of approval to this Regulation to vehicles type approved pursuant to this Regulation before the date stated in paragraph 10.4.
- 10.6. Starting from the date stated in the transitional provisions contained in the 01 series of amendments to Regulation No. 107, Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 36 may refuse the first national registration (first entry into service) of a vehicle type approved pursuant to this Regulation which does not meet the requirements contained in Regulation No. 107 as amended by the 01 series of amendments."
