EXPLANATORY NOTES

General

Status and membership

The Committee is a subsidiary body of the Economic and Social Council, and was previously known as the "Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods". It was reconfigured by the Economic and Social Council's resolution 1999/65 of 26 October 1999 as the Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods and on the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals, with two sub-committees, the Sub-Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods (TDG Sub-Committee) and the Sub-Committee of Experts on the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS Sub-Committee) (refer also to document ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/2001/7). The first session of the Committee was held in Geneva from 11-12 December 2002, and the report was circulated as document ST/SG/AC.10/29 and Adds 1-2. The second session was held in Geneva on 10 December 2004, and the report was circulated as document ST/SG/AC.10/32 and –Adds 1-3 and –Add.3/Corr.1.

Pursuant to the Economic and Social Council's decisions 2001/201B, 2002/201C, 2003/201D and 2005/201C the membership of the Committee is 36, as follows:

Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, China, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, India, Iran (Islamic Republic of), Ireland, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Morocco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Qatar, Russian Federation, Senegal, Serbia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Ukraine, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America and Zambia.

Documentation

The documentation relating to the Committee continues is issued under the symbol ST/SG/AC.10/...

Interpretation

Rules of procedures

In accordance with Rule 27 of the Rules of Procedure of the Economic and Social Council, Chapters VI and VIII to XII of the Rules of Procedure of the Economic and Social Council apply to the proceedings of the Committee and of its sub-committees (refer also to documents ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/2001/1, ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/2001/6).

Mandate

In accordance with resolution 1999/65, the mandate of the Committee is to deal with strategic issues rather than technical issues. It is not envisaged that it would review, change or revisit technical recommendations of the Sub-Committees.

Its main functions are:

- (a) To approve the work programmes of the sub-committees in the light of available resources;
- (b) To coordinate strategic and policy directions in areas of shared interests and overlap;
- (c) To give formal endorsement to the recommendations of the sub-committees and provide the mechanism for channelling them to the Economic and Social Council;
- (d) Facilitate and coordinate the smooth running of the sub-committees.

Timetable

The length of the session has been limited to one day. It will be preceded by the thirtieth session of the TDG Sub-Committee (4-12(a.m.) December 2006) (Agenda: ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/59 and -/Add.1) and the twelfth session of the GHS Sub-Committee (12(p.m.)-14 December 2006) (Agenda: ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/23 and -/Add.1).

1. Adoption of the agenda

In accordance with the established practice, the first item on the agenda is the adoption of the agenda.

2. Election of officers

In accordance with the established practice, the Committee shall elect one President and one or several vice-presidents from among the representatives of its members.

3. Resolutions and decisions of the Economic and Social Council

The resolutions and decisions of the Economic and Social Council of relevance to the work of the Committee during the biennium 2005-2006 are as follows:

4. Work of the Sub-Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods during the biennium 2005-2006

The reports of the TDG Sub-Committee on its twenty-seventh, twenty-eight and twenty-ninth sessions are contained in documents ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/54; ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/56 and -/Add.1; ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/58 and Adds.1-2.

The list of draft amendments to the Recommendations on the Transport of Dangerous Goods, Model Regulations and Manual of Tests and Criteria adopted so far by the Sub-Committee has been consolidated in documents ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2006/101 and ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/58/Add.2.

These draft amendments are still subject to a final reading at the Sub-Committee's thirtieth session (4-12 (a.m.) December 2006) where additional amendment proposals should also be discussed. The report of the Sub-Committee on its thirtieth session will be made available to the Committee either in its final form or in the draft form prepared by the secretariat, as documents ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2006/CRP.3 and addenda for the report proper and ST/SG/AC.10/C.3/2006/CRP.4 and addenda for changes to the consolidated list of draft amendments. The Committee may wish to endorse the draft amendments adopted by the Sub-Committee and any other recommendations made by it.

5. Work of the Sub-Committee of Experts on the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals during the biennium 2005-2006

The reports of the GHS Sub-Committee on its ninth, tenth and eleventh sessions have been issued as documents ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/18, ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/20 and

ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/22. The list of draft amendments to the GHS adopted so far by the Sub-Committee has been consolidated in document ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/2006/19.

The report of the Sub-Committee on its twelfth session will be made available to the Committee either in its final form or under the draft form prepared by the secretariat (ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/2006/CRP.3 and addenda for the report proper and ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/2006/CRP.4 and addenda for any change to the consolidated list of draft amendments). The Committee may wish to endorse the draft amendments adopted by the Sub-Committee and any other recommendations made by it.

6. Programme of work for the biennium 2007-2008

(a) Programme of work and related proposals

The Committee should consider the proposals made by the TDG and the GHS Sub-Committees at their December 2006 sessions for their respective programmes of work, and approve them in the light of resources available for 2007-2008.

(b) Calendar of meetings

The total number of meeting days allocated to the Committee and its sub-committees by the Economic and Social Council for a biennium is 38 days (i.e. 76 meetings of three-hour duration). On the basis of the experience for the biennium 2005-2006, the following dates have been provisionally scheduled by the secretariat for 2007-2008:

The Committee may wish to consider the allocation of meetings for each sub-committee depending on their respective programmes of work.

7. Draft resolution 2007/... of the Economic and Social Council

The Committee may wish to note that both sub-committees will have prepared their own contribution to the draft resolution to be submitted to the Economic and Social Council for

adoption at its 2007 substantive session. The Committee should combine the two parts and adopt the draft resolution to be submitted to the Council.

At the time of writing, there is no issue under this agenda item.

9. Adoption of the report

The Committee should adopt the report on its third session on the basis of a draft prepared by the secretariat.
