II. ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Item 1 Adoption of the Agenda

Item 2 Activities of UNECE Bodies of Interest to the Working Party

(a) Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE)

2. The sixty-second session of the Economic Commission for Europe that is to take place in Geneva from 23-25 April 2007.

3. The Working Party may wish to be informed about the decisions taken by the Commission at its sixty-second session, concerning such questions as the UNECE reform, major policy directions in UNECE's work, and UNECE technical assistance.

(b) Inland Transport Committee and its subsidiary bodies

4. The Inland Transport Committee (ITC) held its sixty-ninth session in Geneva from 6-8 February 2007.

5. The Working Party may wish to be informed about matters of interest considered by the Committee, in particular in the work area of transport statistics of the Committee's report (ECE/TRANS/192).

6. 11. The Working Party may wish to be briefed by the representative of Eurostat about the new developments regarding the Internet version of the Common Questionnaire for Transport Statistics (TRANS/WP.6/151, para. 12).

(c) Web version of the Questionnaire on Road Traffic Accident Statistics

12. The Working Party may wish to be informed by the representative of UNECE and Eurostat about the new developments regarding the Internet version of the Questionnaire for Road Traffic Accidents (TRANS/WP.6/151, para. 14).

(d) Information about further adjustment of the new classification system for transport statistics (NST/2000)

13. The Working Party may wish to discuss and approve Eurostat document "Update of NST 2000, classification of goods in transport statistics".

(e) Transport of gas through pipelines

14. The Working Party may wish to discuss issues related to statistics of gas transport through pipelines. The basis for discussion is document prepared by the Government of Denmark.

(f) Workshop on Statistics of Road Traffic Performance
