- CNG reference fuel specification (measurement, wobble index, display units...)
  - Mixed operation gas/petrol
  - Petrol trim and component protection
  - Dual fuel natural gas/diesel engines

## **New topics addressed during the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting:**

- Regulations 49 and 83: LPG reference fuel discrepancies
  - Regulation 101 (fuel consumption & CO<sub>2</sub> emissions): need for clarification whether to use 1 or 2 reference fuel for gaseous fuels
  - Regulation 115 (retrofit): clarification of the scope, adaptation to technical progress...
  - NMHC–THC emission limit
