II. ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

1. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

In accordance with Chapter III, Rule 7 of the Rules of Procedure of the World Forum (TRANS/WP.29/690), the first item on the provisional agenda is the adoption of the agenda.

2. REGULATION No. 49 (EMISSIONS OF C.I., NG, AND P.I. (LPG) ENGINES)

(a) Off-Cycle Emissions (OCE)

The Chairperson of the OCE working group will summarize the results of the informal meeting held prior to the GRPE session proper. GRPE expects to consider the proposal by the OCE group regarding the draft gtr on OCE as well as the report on the development of the draft gtr.

(b) Gtr No. 4 on Worldwide harmonized Heavy-Duty Certification procedure (WHDC)

GRPE may wish to be informed about the progress of work of the WHDC group. The Chairperson of the working group will summarize the results of the meetings prior to the GRPE session proper.

3. PARTICLE MEASUREMENT PROGRAMME (PMP)

GRPE would like to be informed by the Chairman of the PMP working group about the remaining issue regarding the reduction in the calibration frequency and the results of the heavy-duty validation programme.

4. GTR No. 2 ON THE WORLD-WIDE MOTORCYCLE EMISSION TEST CYCLE (WMTC)

GRPE agreed to consider of a proposal regarding the introduction of performance requirements into gtr No. 2. GRPE also agreed to resume consideration of a proposal to correct and improve in the gtr the provisions on gear-shift prescriptions.

5. EXHAUST EMISSIONS TEST PROTOCOL OF NON-ROAD MOBILE MACHINERY (NRMM)

The Chairman of the NRMM working group will inform GRPE about the progress made at the meeting prior to the GRPE session proper. GRPE expects to consider a first proposal by the working group regarding the draft gtr on NRMM.

6. AMENDMENTS TO UNECE REGULATIONS

(a) Worldwide harmonized Light vehicles Test Procedures (WLTP)

GRPE may wish to be informed by the Chairperson of the informal group about the progress made by the WLTP working group during its meeting held prior to the GRPE session proper.

(b) Gas-fuelled Vehicles (GFV)

GRPE may wish to be informed by the Chairperson of the GFV working group about the results of the meeting held prior to the GRPE session proper.

(c) Regulation No. 83 (Emissions of M₁ and N₁ categories of vehicles)

GRPE agreed to resume consideration of the updated proposals by Germany and OICA to amend in Regulation No. 83 the regenerating calculation factor (K_i) for multiple periodic regenerating systems and to update the specifications for the hydrocarbon analyser, which is used during the vehicle emission tests.

(d) Regulation No. 85 (Measurement of net power)

GRPE agreed to have a final review of a proposal by the expert from the European Commission to align the provisions of Regulation No. 85 with those of the current EU Directive.

(e) Regulation No. 101 (CO₂ emissions/fuel consumption)

GRPE may wish to consider a proposal to amend the Regulation , if available.

7. HYDROGEN AND FUEL CELL VEHICLES – SUB-GROUP ENVIRONMENT (HFCV-SGE)

GRPE is expected to be informed by the HFCV project manager about the sub-group's activities.

8. ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY VEHICLES (EFVs)

GRPE may wish to be informed by the Chairperson of the informal group about the progress made by the EFV working group during its meeting held in Bonn, on 30-31 October 2008. GRPE is expected to be informed about the provisional agenda of the informal group's meeting scheduled to be held on Friday, after conclusion of the GRPE session proper.

9. FUEL QUALITY (FQ)

GRPE may wish to be informed about the results of the FQ working group's meeting held prior to the GRPE session proper.

10. EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION ON NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL REQUIREMENTS ON EMISSIONS

GRPE may wish to continue the exchange of views on the development of national or regional legislation and international requirements concerning emissions.

GRPE may wish to consider any other subject, if necessary.
