Listing, classification and packing**Special provision 272****Transmitted by the expert from Germany¹**

1. SP 272 states that “This substance shall not be transported under the provisions of class 4.1 unless specially authorized by the competent authority (see UN 0143).” SP 272 is assigned to:

- UN 3319 NITROGLYCERIN MIXTURE, DESENZITIZED, SOLID, N.O.S with more than 2% but not more than 10 % nitroglycerin, by mass; and
- UN 3344 PENTAERYTHRITOL TETRANITRATE (PENTAERYTHRITOL TETRANITRATE; PETN) MIXTURE, DESENZITIZED, SOLID, N.O.S. with more than 10% but not more than 20 % PETN, by mass.

2. The reference to UN 0143 does not apply to UN 3344. The corresponding entry for UN 3344 would be UN 0150. Therefore it is proposed to add a reference to UN 0150 to SP 272 as follows:

“272 This substance shall not be transported under the provisions of class 4.1 unless specially authorized by the competent authority (see UN 0143 or UN 0150).”
