Proposal 3

7. Amend the Guiding Principles for assigning portable tank instructions to Division 4.3 liquids as follows:

4.3 Liquids	I	Any other than 6.1/8	T9 or T15 ^a or T21^b	
	II	Any other than 6.1/8	T7	
	III	Any other than 6.1/8	T7	
4.3 Liquids	I	6.1 or 8	T10 or T14 ^a or T21^b	
	II	6.1 or 8	T7 or T11 ^a	
	III	6.1 or 8	T7	

^a This instruction shall be assigned to n.o.s. substances and may also be assigned based on the absolute vapour pressure of the substance.

^b This instruction shall be assigned to Division 4.3 packing group I liquids which may ignite in contact with water or moist air.
