Extended mandate for the informal correspondence group on the editorial revision of Chapters 3.2 and 3.3

Transmitted by the expert from Germany

Informal correspondence group on the editorial revision of Chapters 3.2 and 3.3 of the GHS to bring forward a proposal for guidance related to skin and eye irritation dealing with the evaluation of existing studies with more than three animals.

The guidance for the evaluation of studies with more than three animals must not lower the level of protection as compared to the existing criteria in tables 3.2.2, 3.3.1 and 3.3.2 of the GHS.
