

Proposal for Corrigendum 2 to the 05 series amendment to Regulation No. 48

Note: The modifications to the current text of the regulation, including ECE/TRANS/WP.29/2011/25, are marked in bold or strikethrough characters.

I. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 12.21. to 12.26., amend to read:

- "12.21. As from the official date of entry into force of the 05 series of amendments, no Contracting Party applying this Regulation shall refuse to grant approval under this Regulation as amended by the 05 series of amendments.
- 12.22. As from 48 months from the official date of entry into force of the 05 series of amendments, Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall grant approvals only if the vehicle type to be approved meets the requirements of this Regulation as amended by the 05 series of amendments. However, As from 66 months for new vehicles types of categories M₁ and N₁ and 84 months for new vehicle types of other categories after the official date of entry into force of the 05 series of amendments to this Regulation, Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall grant approvals only if the new vehicle type to be approved meet the requirements of this Regulation as amended by the 05 series of amendments excluding paragraphs 6.2.7.6.2. and 6.2.7.6.3. to 6.2.7.6.3.3. Existing approvals under this Regulation granted before these dates will remain valid indefinitely and extensions of these approvals shall continue to be granted after.
- 12.23. Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall continue to grant approvals to those types of vehicles which comply with the requirements of this Regulation as amended by the preceding series of amendments during the 48 months' period which follows the date of entry into force of the 05 series of amendments.
- 12.24. No Contracting Party applying this Regulation shall refuse national or regional type approval of a vehicle type approved to the 05 series of amendments to this Regulation.
- ~~12.25. Until 48 months after the date of entry into force of the 05 series of amendments to this Regulation, no Contracting Party applying this Regulation shall refuse national or regional type approval of a vehicle type approved to the preceding series of amendments to this Regulation.~~
- 12.265. Existing approvals under this Regulation before the date of entry into force of the 05 series of amendment to this Regulation shall remain valid indefinitely. "

II. JUSTIFICATION

Paragraph 12.25. is not needed because there is no transitional provision of the 05 series for first national or regional registration. It should be deleted to prevent misinterpretation that starting 48 months after the entry into force of the 05 series of amendments to this Regulation, Contracting Parties applying this Regulation may refuse first national or regional registration (first entry into service) of a vehicle which does not meet the requirements of the 05 series of amendments to this Regulation.
